

## **COELOGYNE SCHILLERIANA**



## Origin: Asia

*Temperatures:* Hot to cool growing small orchid species *Light:* Bright shade

<u>Watering & Fertilizing</u>: Regular watering and fertilizing in active growing season, goes deciduous, old leaves will fall off for the winter – no fertilizing from October, and no watering with only light spraying during the winter time to keep pseudobulbs from shriveling.

<u>General care:</u> Our favorite Coelogyne, stunning huge blooms appear in late winter / spring when waking up from dormancy. Compact small grower, and easy to grow too. Bright shade, hot to cool temperatures, potted or mounted. This is deciduous species, old leaves will fall off, stop fertilizing in fall, and spray only lightly in the winter time till new growths appear in the spring. Great for outdoor / indoor growing, windowsills or greenhouses. Can be grown in Florida outside year-round
