CONCHIDIUM / DENDROBIUM EXTINGTORIUM



Origin: Nepal & Myanmar

Temperatures: Intermediate to warm growing mini – miniature orchid species

Light: Bright light

Watering & Fertilizing: Regular watering and fertilizing in active growing season, deciduous species, old leaves will fall off for the winter dormancy – no fertilizing from October, and no watering with only light spraying during the winter time to keep pseudobulbs from shriveling.

General care: Interesting pseudobulbs that go completely dormant for the winter and spikes in the spring. Bright shade in the summer and bright light in the winter, grows best under warm to intermediate temperatures but can take cool too, mounted. This is deciduous species, old leaves will fall off, stop fertilizing in fall, and spray only lightly in the winter time till new growths appear in the spring. Great for outdoor / indoor growing, windowsills or greenhouses. Can be grown in Florida outside year-round
