


CONCHIDIUM RHOMBOIDALE/ ERIA RHOMBOIDALIS



Origin: Asia

Temperatures: Warm to cold growing small orchid species

Light: Bright light

Watering & Fertilizing: Regular watering and fertilizing in active growing season, semi - deciduous species, old leaves will fall off for the winter dormancy – no fertilizing from October, only light watering during the winter time.

General care: Interesting Eria species with large blooms. Bright shade in the summer and bright light in the winter, grows best under warm to cool temperatures, potted or mounted. Semi - deciduous species, old leaves will fall off, stop fertilizing in fall, water only lightly in the winter time till new growths appear in the spring. Great for outdoor / indoor growing, windowsills or greenhouses. Can be grown in Florida outside year-round
