

MICROCOELIA GILPINAE



Origin: Madagascar

Temperatures: Hot to cold growing small orchid species

Light: Bright light

Watering & Fertilizing: Regular watering and fertilizing spring to fall,

slightly less in the winter time, high humidity.

<u>General care:</u> Probably one of the prettiest leafless orchids due to its vivid orange-colored blooms. This species is still rarely seen in cultivation. Grows best under cold to hot conditions, in bright light, good air movement and good humidity letting slightly dry out. Can be grow mounted. Great plant for terrariums, vivariums, indoor growing on windowsills or greenhouses and outdoors in proper zones.
