

OCTARRHENA PARVULA



Origin: Asia

Temperatures: Warm to cool growing miniature size orchid species

Light: Bright shade

Watering & Fertilizing: Regular watering and fertilizing year-round **General care:** One of the less common miniature orchid species in cultivation, Octarrhena is quite a cute addition to any collection. Fan shape growing habit looks more like a tiny palm trees growing from the pot or mount. Does best when grown intermediate, bright shade, good air movement and likes to dry out between waterings. It does not like over water and does not like to be buried deep in media – very loosely potted or mounted works the best. Great plants for terrariums, glass orbs, windowsills, greenhouse growing and outside in proper zones.
