

## PHALAENOPSIS APPENDICULATA



Origin: Malaysia

**Temperatures:** Intermediate to hot growing miniature size orchid species

*Light:* Bright shade

Watering & Fertilizing: Regular watering and fertilizing year-round General care: By far the smallest and most attractive Phalaenopsis species in the world. These are still very rare in cultivation and highly sought-after. They grow well if proper conditions are provided. Grows best under warm to intermediate temperatures, in bright shade with high humidity and air movement. Can be grown potted or mounted with some moss. To achieve successful blooming humidity must be constant and not fluctuate otherwise bud will keep blasting. Can be grown outside in Florida year-round, does excellent in terrariums, vivariums or glass orbs or in greenhouses where humidity can be kept constantly high.
