

PORPAX USTULATA / ERIA USTULATA



Origin: Asia

Temperatures: Hot to intermediate growing miniature size orchid species

Light: Shade

<u>Watering & fertilizing:</u> Regular watering and fertilizing when in active growing season, goes dormant for the winter months - no fertilizing from October, no watering from December till new growths appear, with some light misting once a week to protect bulbs to shriveling.

<u>General care:</u> Porpax plants are becoming more and more popular among orchid growers. Their strange pseudobulbs, even stranger blooms and interesting growing habit makes them quite intriguing. They go through yearly cycle when they will be dormant (completely leafless) during the resting period from late fall till late spring/early summer, and proper care must be provided during dormancy to have success growing Porpax. Grows best under cold to warm conditions, in shade, good air movement and high humidity. Can be grown potted or mounted (we prefer mounted). Great plant for terrariums, vivariums, glass orbs, vases, indoor growing on windowsills or greenhouses and outdoors year-round in proper zones.
