Origin: Ecuador & Colombia

Temperatures: Cold to intermediate growing creeping miniature size orchid species

Light: Bright shade

Watering & fertilizing: Regular watering and fertilizing year-round, high humidity and good quality water.

General care: Definitely a great buy and something rare in cultivation, this is one of our favorite Porroglossum species, first for its scrambling growing habit, second for its stunning red blooms. Grows best under intermediate to cool conditions, in shade / bright shade, good air movement and high humidity. Good quality water. This Porroglossum will scramble all over the place and it does bloom once it is hanging down the pots or mounts freely, it also can tolerate bright light! Can be grown potted or mounted. Great plant for terrariums, vivariums, glass orbs, vases, indoor growing on windowsills or greenhouses and outdoors.
