MICRO, MINIATURE AND SMALL ORCHIDS

## PINALIA / ERIA MYRISTICIFORMIS



**Origin:** Asia

**Temperatures:** Hot to intermediate growing small size orchid species

**Light:** Bright light

**Watering & Fertilizing:** Regular watering and fertilizing during active growing season, dormant in the wintertime.

**General care:** Very unusual and still quite rare orchid species in Dendrobium family with cute blooms and interesting pseudobulbs when dormant. Grows best under hot to intermediate conditions, in bright filtered light, high humidity and air good air movement. Deciduous in the winter time – do not fertilize since October, no watering (only light misting) during dormancy till new growths appear. Can be grown potted or mounted. Great plant for terrariums, vivariums, greenhouses and outdoors in proper zones.
