## Check-in at the office with Kelley and obtain:

- Make sure to read and sign the Daily Orientation sheet.
- Make sure you've parked in the designated WATCH D.O.G. parking spot located near the gym.

## Assist with student arrival in the pick-up area in front of the school.

- Wave hello to the students.
- Welcome them to school with a smile on your face.
- You're the WATCH D.O.G. for the day have fun with it!

8:40-8:55

## Return to the office to get ready for the day.

- Kelley will take a photo of you and your student(s) for the WATCH D.O.G. Wall of Fame bulletin board.
  - Make sure to give your student(s) some WATCH D.O.G. swag from the drawer. We have pencils and book marks this year.
- Check to see if any teachers, other than your student's, have signed up to have you help in their classroom for the day. If so, note the time(s) and the room number(s) so you can easily navigate there at the appropriate time.
  - You should have already contacted your student's teacher(s)
    the week prior to volunteering. Make sure that their
    classroom(s) are the first you visit during the three designated
    time slots to volunteer in classrooms (see below).
- Take a stack of "Polar Bear Tickets" with you to give out during the day as you observe students 1) Showing Respect, 2) Making Good Decisions, and 3) Solving Problems.
- Take a few "Paw Prints" to give out to students who go above and beyond modeling *The Polar Bear Way*.

11:00-11:15	<b>Check in with the office.</b> See if Kelley or anyone else has something you can help with. If not, and you haven't patrolled the hallways / building, do that at this time.
11:20-1:10	<ul> <li>Lunch and Recess.</li> <li>You are encouraged to each lunch with your student(s).</li> <li>Visit with students during their lunch time and recess and ask them how their day is going.</li> </ul>
1:15- 1:30	Check back in with the office for anything they need help with.
1:35-2:10	<b>P.M. Recess</b> – interact with kids outside, start a game, high five kids making good choices, curtail bullying, hand out Polar Bear Tickets.
2:15-2:45	Volunteer opportunity #3 to help in a classroom (either your children's or another teacher who has asked for your help).
2:50-3:20	Assist with student dismissal in the drop-off area in front of the school.
