Executive Summary

The following are the results of the survey from the 2017 Fall Rally in Branson, MO. There are two sections to this report the first is the numerical results and the second is the written comments. The information from this survey and surveys from other rallies will be used to improve our rallies. Please fill free to provide feedback to your Rally Master Allen Jackson.

We received 17 completed surveys. As with any survey given to and completed by different people, the views of one person may not align with someone else. However, the results show that Monaco America needs to focus on Seminars and Vendors while maintaining a high quality in the other areas. For those questions with a selection of 5 to1 and N/A, the assessment is divided into 2 parts for each question. The 5 and 4 responses are considered positive, and the 3, 4,5 and N/A responses are group as possibly needing work. For example: the question "Were you satisfied with the menu" showed a positive response in 93.75% of the surveys while 6.25% of surveys showed needing work.
