All registrations received and paid by February 1, 2024 will be entered into a drawing for 2 free Branson show tickets. *What can you expect in Branson?* Our Monaco America club will be providing five nights of camping, Sunday through Thursday (May 5, 6, 7, 8, 9) and three nights of dinners plus our fabulous potluck dinner on Sunday night.

On Monday night, we will have a catered Italian dinner followed by singer Kenny Evans. He was the opening act touring with Kenny Chesney, Lonestar, Charlie Daniels, and more. He was also a featured concert at Walt Disney World during the 1990's. He has an amazing four and half octave vocal range.

On Tuesday night we will have a Hillbilly dinner and party (please plan to dress the part) filled with music, comedy, entertainment, and prizes for the top three hillbillies.

Wednesday night will be left open so that you can take advantage of the over 100 amazing shows playing in Branson. There will also be free time during the day on Wednesday that you can use to choose entertainment downtown as well. We will give you more details about what is available as we get closer to the event.

Thursday evening will be our legendary Card Bingo night.

*What will we be doing while we are in Branson?* We will visit the College of the Ozarks with many tour stops where you will have the option of eating a student-prepared and served farm-to-table lunch. The cost for this lunch is \$31 per person and advance reservations are recommended. We will visit the Dewey Short visitor's center where you can learn about Table Rock Lake, the dam, local habitats, beautiful murals, and a viewing deck where you can see both Table Rock Lake and Lake Taneycomo from one place. The college tour and visitor's center are both free. The optional lunch at the college is an additional cost.

There will be time available on Monday morning for the golfers in our group. There are eight great courses in the area where we can find time for you to get in a round. At the same time on Monday morning, we will offer a unique option (payable in advance on your registration form @ \$35 per person) for the Redneck Comedy Bus Tour. Want to know the difference between a hillbilly and a redneck? Do you know the difference between Mountain Dew, white lightnin', and moonshine? Are mullets and camo still cool? If you want to know the answers to these questions and want to laugh all morning, then sign up for this tour as we tour Branson in our camouflage bus. You may actually learn something about the area while laughing.

On Thursday we will have another optional excursion also payable in advance on your registration form. If you choose this option, we will be going on a paddlewheel boat, named the Showboat Branson Belle, to have a 3-course lunch and see a variety show of singing, dancing, and comedy all while cruising the beautiful Table Rock Lake. This is a real bargain at \$35 per person.

We have 30 camping sites guaranteed at the RV park so get your registration in early to make sure you get in on the fun and be entered in our free ticket drawing.

Our destination will be Chattanooga, Tennessee; however, the RV park is actually located a few miles south in Rossville, Georgia. The dates will be October 6-10, 2024 (departing on the 11th). Put this date on your calendar and plan your travels to make sure you can attend this rally. Details about this rally will be posted on our website as they are formulated but some of the attractions in the Chattanooga area are:

- Lookout Mountain at 2,000 feet high, you can see seven states
- Ruby Falls a 145-foot underground water fall
- Incline Railway the steepest passenger railway in the world, an amazing 72.7% grade
- Rock City beautiful, enchanted gardens
- Tennessee Aquarium and 3D IMAX Theatre
- Southern Belle River Boat Fall foliage sightseeing tours
- Tennessee Valley Railroad Museum
- Chickamauga and Chattanooga National Military Park
- Raccoon Mountain Caverns
- Classic Arcade Pinball Museum
