Tech Topic

All of our coaches have two air conditioning systems. A house air conditioning system powered by 120 volt AC power (shore power or generator) and a chassis air conditioning system powered by the coach engine. The engine must be running to operate the chassis air conditioning system, so we just turn on the dash heat/AC switch as we travel down the road. A critical component of the chassis air conditioning system is the electrically driven condenser fan, which, on diesels, can be difficult to check with the engine running.

An easy way to check this fan operation, on diesel coaches, is to turn the ignition key to the ON position and turn the dash heat/AC switch to the AC position, and then go to the rear of the coach and at the lower side air intake, listen for the fan to be running. Also, if you place you hand on the **FRONT** (outside) of this air intake, you can feel air being drawn from the outside of the coach into the chassis area and this confirms proper condenser fan operation. **DO NOT** put your hand on the inner side of this air intake! Even though the condenser fan has a guard

on the blades, don't put you hand there to find out! On the gas coaches, the chassis air conditioning condenser fans) are also electrically driven and supplement the engine driven radiator cooling fan. These can be visually observed for proper operation but the engine must be running to do this.
