

Safety Notification

According to rules established by the National Fire Protection Agency, a US trade association, all recreational vehicles are required to have a 5 lb BC fire extinguisher on board. Your motor home probably included a fire extinguisher. You should check your fire extinguisher, and those in your home, to see if they have been recalled.

If your fire extinguisher was manufactured by Kidde, it may be recalled. Check to see if it has a plastic handle or a plastic push button. If so, it most likely is on a recall list. Contact Kidde toll-free at 855-271-0773 from 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. ET Monday through Friday, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. ET Saturday and Sunday, or go on-line at www.kidde.com and click on "Product Safety Recall" for more information. If your extinguisher has been recalled, Kidde will replace it at no cost to you.

You will need to know your Model Number, Serial Number, and Date Code (if applicable). You will find instructions for locating this information on the Kidde website.
