
a dedicated and talented group of artisans and master crafters who both demonstrate and sell their works."



FMCA

Results of the FMCA Governing Board Meeting on July 12, 2017

The Family Motor Coach Association is a volunteer owned and volunteer managed not-for-profit corporation. The FMCA leadership structure consists of an Executive Board that conducts the day to day operations, a Governing Board that provides direction to the Executive Board and submits proposals for the Members to approve or disapprove. Ultimately, the Membership controls FMCA by electing National Directors to serve on the Governing Board. Any changes to the FMCA Articles of Incorporation and the Constitution must be approved by the Membership.

Monaco America is represented on the Governing Board by our National Director, Sonny Hodge, and our Alternate National Director, Bert Garcia. The FMCA Governing Board met on July 12, 2017 at the 96th International Convention in Indianapolis, Indiana. Bert Garcia attended the Indianapolis convention to represent Monaco America.

The GB approved a proposal to change all references in the Articles of Incorporation, the Constitution, and By-Laws, from "motor coaches" and similar terms to "recreational vehicles." The intent of this change is to allow towable RVs to join FMCA as full members. A towable was defined as a self-contained wheeled vehicle that includes permanently installed cooking, sleeping, and sanitary facilities.

The GB did not take the decision to allow towable RVs to join FMCA lightly. There was considerable discussion that FMCA is on a trajectory of decline. The average age of FMCA members is 73 and the average age of towable RV owners is 39. Sales of towable RVs outnumber motor homes approximately four to one. FMCA membership has been declining at a steady rate of about 5,000 per year, though this trend has slowed recently due to a significant membership recruiting effort. Adding towable RVs to the membership roll is expected to bring additional revenue from membership dues, increase convention and rally attendance, bring more advertising revenue from the FMCA magazine, and increase manufacturer and vendor participation in FMCA.

The FMCA Membership must approved the proposal to allow towable RVs into FMCA with 65% of the Membership voting in the affirmative. The Executive Board will conduct the voting, which is anticipated to occur by written ballots mailed directly to the voting Members. Voting is expected to happen starting in December 2017 after a proper notice period of at least 120 days.

The GB considered two other proposals. One would prohibit two family members from concurrently holding an elected position on the Executive Board. This proposal was rejected, and the GB recognized that in many instances family members act as a team to the betterment of FMCA. The second proposal would change the non-discrimination language in FMCA documents by expanding the definition to include gender expression, sex, sexual orientation, religion, color, marital or family status, age nationality, disability or political beliefs. The GB rejected this proposal as an attempt to inject politically correct language to the detriment of FMCA. The GB allowed the existing non-discrimination language to remain as "race, age, gender, national origin, or disability."

The GB elected the following people to the Executive Board: Jon Walker, President; Rett Porter, Senior Vice President; Gaye Young, National Secretary; and John Reynolds, Treasurer. Their two-year terms began on July 15, 2017.

A written report of all GB actions will be submitted to the Monaco America Executive Board at their October 2017 meeting and a verbal report will be given to the membership at the Fall rally in Branson, MO in October.

I was honored to represent Monaco America as your Alternate National Director. FMCA provides considerable support and benefits to our membership. Our participation on the Governing Board is our opportunity to inform FMCA of our opinions through our vote.




