This is my first newsletter. Carol's work is a hard act to follow. I'll get better with practice.



For the Marengo Rally we will be sponsoring the Heartbeat of Morrow County which is a crisis pregnancy and new life prenatal center. Their needs are many. They provide for children up to size 5T. Sleepers and gowns in neutral colors, S,M,&L onesies, 3 pack baby bottles and pacifiers, changing pads, receiving blankets and burp pads, toddler and pre-school socks and un-

derwear to size 5, hooded bath towels and wash cloths, sheets for cribs, pack-nplay and bassinet, diaper bags, shampoo and lotion but no oil or powder. They make up little gift bags with small stuffed animals, teething rings, rattles and brush and comb sets. They will also take very gently used items. If you buy winter things such as coats, sweatshirts, boots, mittens, scarves and hats that are on sale later this year and they are always in need of them. They do not need diapers—there is a diaper manufacturer nearby and they keep them supplied all the time. Money is always appreciated; they buy cribs, mattresses and strollers. Just about anything you would give them will be used.




### Monaco America Website
