Put the lids on, and we can remove them and stack them for storage.

I'm sure everyone has their list for things like checking your tires, batteries, and such but making a list of what you're taking for the inside of the coach ahead of time and checking it off as you put it in can cut down on things you may forget, but also can help you to not overload! When you look at the list, you might very well eliminate some things. Not to mention you have peace driving down the road knowing you have your prescriptions and everything that was important you need.

Also, don't forget about checking your house out before you leave and to be sure someone is aware of your travel plans, how often you'll be "checking-in" with them, and how to reach you in an emergency. (Yes, make another list!)

Think of the places you are going to see and the friends you are going to catch up with! It can make the planning a lot of fun!

Rally price includes 4 nights (Mon, Tue, Wed, Thurs) camping with full hookups (50 amp site assigned as paid reservation is received), Welcome Gathering, 3 breakfasts, 3 evening meals, entertainment, vendors, seminars, social/cocktail hours, Ladies Tea, craft classes (additional cost may apply for craft classes) and all the fun that is a Monaco America Rally. (Early arrivals prior to Monday May 11th will need to dry camp at gate 4 & 5 at \$10/night plus tax; Stay past Thursday you must pay the park direct their customary rate.. Early arrivals and late departures CALL the park for reservations at 574-533-3247. DO NOT arrive early and park in a 50 amp site unless directed by the MA parking committee, you will have to relocate.

Handicapped: Must have a state issued handicapped placard displayed on your coach.

- * Passport attendees are eligible for all meals, entertainment, seminars and exhibits. No camping is included in this package.
