### **Tech Topic**

Some of you may have read my tech article in the Summer 2008 issue regarding the 2-speed fan clutch for Monaco coaches that have a rearfacing radiator and engine cooling fan. Cummins Crosspoint, the Indianapolisbased Cummins distributor who has supported most of our Monaco America rallies in the past, offers this 2-speed fan clutch kit as an aftermarket product. At the time of my initial Newsletter article, I also wrote a more comprehensive article that is listed as 2spd\_Fan.pdf under "Files" on our Club website <u>www.groups.yahoo.com/</u> group/monaco-america.

. After my initial articles were published, I discovered a previously unknown but very important operational characteristic of the fan clutch that significantly affects the fuel economy improvement you will experience with this product. It relates to how the fan clutch responds to commands from the engine ECM to operate in the "idle-speed" mode. It also elevates the benefit of having an indicator light to alert you whenever the engine ECM calls for the fan clutch to engage the fan in the "high-speed" operating mode. Accordingly, I have updated the web-

site file **2-spd\_Fan.pdf** extensively to fully explain this operational characteristic and to describe specific driving techniques that will ensure you get the maximum fuel economy benefit from the fan clutch. I encourage all of you who have the **2-speed** fan clutch on your coach, as well as those of you who may be considering having the fan clutch installed on your coach, to read the revised and updated file **2-spd\_Fan.pdf** posted on the club website.
