

Community Book Project creates ways to get more books into the hands of more kids; especially those furthest from educational justice.



#### Community

CBP's commitment to the youth of Seattle is unwavering. We've rapidly grown to reach children aged birth to 11 years old across 10 zip codes. In the first six months of operations, we mailed more than 2,500 kids approx 12,000 books! We also gave hundreds of books through distributions, free libraries and more.



#### Innovative

Community Book Project combines solid educational foundations, science-backed programming, and a start-up entrepreneurial mindset to operate frugally and with agility and innovation. Our FY2024 modest budget of \$55,000 will achieve so much and we have new initiatives in the works. CBP is attracting new volunteers and partners eager to expand our mission.



At our organization, we strongly believe in the transformative power of books, especially when it comes to positively impacting children and the communities they belong to. Our mission is to promote a love for reading and enhance access to educational opportunities by providing free books and valuable resources to children.



#### Zip Codes Across Seattle

We currently cover the expense to mail books from Dolly Parton's Imagination Library to kids in the following areas:

#### Partner Schools

Community Book Project currently provides literacy support to two public elementary schools in South Seattle. Through this program we provide new, high-interest & diverse books to students, collaborate on other events, such as literacy and multi-cultural nights, and have initiatives in the works to help prevent the Summer slide.

#### Little Free Libraries (and counting)

CBP stocks a number of Little Free Libraries around the city. We provide fresh books weekly, ensuring kids have continuous access to new and interesting reading materials. We are working to build our own reading hubs in a few neighborhoods particularly lacking in access to books.
