Crying helps exercise the child's lungs.

### What they don't tell you about crying

Crying is a sign that there is something distressing them. Children are easily susceptible to stress and crying is their way of calling out for help.

When children stop prolonged crying, it is because they are exhausted.

Prolonged crying affects the child's brains and leave lasting impacts for later life.

#### Why you should avoid prolonged crying

Their brains will become flooded with potentially neurotoxic stress hormones (eg. Cortisol).

Regular experiences of crying could lead to permanent oversensituity and over-reactivity in the stress response system of the tirain

# Effects of Oversensitive Response System

- 1. Predisposition for anxiety and clinical depression 2. Poor mental and physical health 3. Increased use of alcohol for stress relief

- 4. Propensity for violence
