ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned adult natural person, acting as incorporator, hereby establishes a nonprofit corporation pursuant to the Colorado Revised Nonprofit Corporation Act and adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE ! Name

The name of the corporation is THE DEER CREEK AT NORTHGATE HOMEOWNER'S ASSOCIATION, INC. (the "Association"). FILED CHISTOMER CONV

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 Purposes

 The purposes and objectives for which this Association is formed (none of which shall be for pecuniary association for the owners in Deer Creek at Northgate, a residential means of self-government for the owners of the means of self-government for the owners of the means of Deer Creek at Northgata ("Declaration") and all amendments thereto, which Declaration will be recorded in the real property records of El Paso County, Colorado.
 - To provide for the care, management, control, preservation operation, maintenance, repair, (b) restoration and replacement of the areas required or permitted to be maintained by the Association, in the manner prescribed by the Declaration, and to provide other services with respect to such areas deemed advantageous by the Owners of Lots in the Community Area or required or authorized under the Declaration.
 - To promote the safety and welfare of the Owners (as such term is defined in the Declaration). 79/0/ado Law. (C)
 - (d) To adopt and enforce rules and regulations as permitted in the Declaration.
 - (e) To levy and enforce adequate assessments to meet all expenses of the Association.
 - To enforce, in its own name or on behalf of its Members (as defined in the Declaration), the protective covenants, conditions and restrictions set forth in the Declaration and in rules and regulations of the Association and to seek recress for the violation of any provisions, by any and all remedies available at law or equity or authorized under the Declaration.
 - To exercise any and all other rights, powers and authority and undertake such actions as may be necessary, convenient or useful in connection with the governance of the Association and the performance of the Association's functions as set forth in the Declaration.

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ARTICLE IV Additional Powers

In furtherance of the purposes and objectives (but not otherwise) set forth in the Declaration and subject to the restrictions set forth therein, the Association shall have and may exercise all of the powers and do everything necessary or convenient for the accomplishment of any of the corporate purposes either alone or in connection with other corporations, firms or individuals, and either as principal or agent, subject to such limitations as are or may be prescribed by the laws of the State of Colorado.

ARTICLE V Restrictions Upon the Powers

No part of the net earnings of the Association (other than in furtherance of the purposes of the Association, and other than a rebate of excess assessments) shall inure to the benefit of any Member, director or officer of the Association, or any other individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the Association affecting one or more or no purposes, open services rendered to or for the Association, any corporate assets remaining after the payment of all debts will be distributed to its open services to their present and obligations.
