Email your request to Michael Atencio (above) or submit it through the Homeowner Portal at rowcal.com. It's easy and it's free, and it will save you a lot of headaches later.

New RowCal Management

Helpful Insights for Transfer

Last month we learned that Diversified Association Management "partnered" with RowCal Management effective July 1st. Michael Atencio will remain our managing agent, otherwise all other transactions must be directed through the RowCal "Homeowner Portal" at www.rowcal.com. All homeowners should have received a welcome packet with instructions how to open an account. If you didn't, call the RowCal "Care Team" at (719) 471-1703 during business hours to request your packet (select option "0" to speak to an agent). It contains important information including your account number which will be necessary to make any future payments by check.

Creating an account on the RowCal "Homeowner Portal" is pretty standard by today's conventions. From your internet browser you will first access rowcal.com. Per instructions, you will select the "Homeowner Login" button at top. Next window you will select the "Sign In" button towards bottom. Next window you will select "Create Account". Next window you will enter your basic account information and indicate how you would like to be listed in the online directory. After completing the homeowner form, you will select "Register" at bottom and wait for RowCal to send you email confirmation. The email will contain a link to let you set your password. Click the link and set your password. Finally, return to the "Sign In" page and enter your email and password. Congratulations, you now have a RowCal account.

The RowCal "Homeowner Portal" lets you view your account balance, make payments, submit an architectural change request, view a community calendar, and review HOA documents. This last feature is not yet active, but you can still find all HOA documents and other information without logging-in at our public website, deercreekcos.com.

Xeriscape Option

Deer Creek Covenants 6.4.1 stipulates that "Lot Owners shall maintain, replace and keep in good repair in accordance with the requirements of the... Design Review Guidelines all drainage swales, slopes, trees, shrubs, grass and other landscaping on their Lots." (Find Covenants at deercreekcos.com.) After 20 years' drought, water is becoming an increasingly precious commodity and lush green lawns more expensive. The City now limits watering to no more than three days a week. In recognition of these facts, Deer Creek in 2014 adopted new Design Guidelines facilitating the installation of xeriscape landscapes requiring little or no irrigation. If continually rising water bills are a concern, you may want to consider xeriscaping. Colorado State University offers some good advice addressing conditions unique to Colorado. Just Google "xeriscape CSU" to find their website. The City also offers tips for conserving water by creating a "Water Wise" landscape. Go to www.csu.ora/Page/WaterWiseBasics.aspx. or visit a demonstration garden at 2855 Mesa Rd. or 3920 Dublin Blvd. Please remember to run your plans by the Design Review Committee before making any changes (see bottom left front page). More importantly, don't just let your yard die. Part of the appeal and why we chose to live in Deer Creek was the beautiful appearance of the community. Let us all do our part to maintain that. Thank you.
