The Stamp depicted is Scott #292 \$1 Black

"Western Cattle in Storm"

It is considered by many to be the most beautiful U.S. stamp ever issued. Taken from a painting called "The Vanguard" by Scottish artist J. A. MacWhirter, it actually shows a group of Scottish cattle in a snowstorm in the West Highlands! The superb engraving and scarcity make this issue highly sought after for most all collectors of Classic U.S. stamps.



Your Regional Philatelic Library

The San Diego Philatelic Library is an educational and literary endeavor operated by the San Diego County Philatelic Council, the not for profit entity incorporated to serve the collectors of San Diego County. The Library was established to promote and facilitate the pursuit of stamp collecting at all levels, from novice to international exhibitor.

Those of us who utilize the San Diego Philatelic Library are proud of what has been accomplished by its unpaid Volunteers. The all-volunteer organization has about 28 individuals who provide various services to operate the facility. These folks work to keep the doors open, and draw as many interested parties as possible into the service area. The Library hours vary based upon who can take a shift, currently 10 - 2 Monday, 12 to 5:30 Tuesday, 12 to 3 Wednesday, and from 1 to 5 Saturday, plus additional hours by appointment only.

Many generous philatelists have donated almost everything imaginable to the Library. The Philatelic Council, which allocates space to the P-25 monthly, and the Poway Stamp Club for their bimonthly meetings, has 501(c) status with the Internal Revenue Service as well as California, and as such is a public charity. Donors of gifts, books, catalogs, albums, covers, stamps, etc. to the Library are entitled to a charitable deduction from itemized adjusted gross incomes. Some of those donations are re-gifted to youth groups or other kids interested in the hobby. Some may go to John Hotchner's Stamps for the Wounded, in Falls Church Virginia through the Library's oldest volunteer, 99 year old Bob Lackner. But most goes to sale to keep the lights on.

Be sure to watch for SDPL sales on E-bay at the Library's on-line store (see sandiegophilateliclibrary.org). Quarterly voice sales are another integral part of the library, and as feasible, the Library holds these auctions at its Poway location. The next Library Auction will be held Saturday June 9, 2018. Together with library sales of other donations in local stamp shows, or regional or national auctions in Harmer or Spink auction houses, all revenue supports the Library.

One of the most active groups meeting at the library is the Poway Stamp Club which holds its meetings at 6:30 sharp, the second and fourth Wednesday of each month. But the SDPL is far more than just a library; their knowledgeable volunteers can offer assistance to persons who have "inherited" stamp accumulations, helping them find the value and sale options for their collections. The friendly and courteous library staff works to help individual collectors, and provide the premier Philatelic center for the Southern California region, only one of eight independent library research centers in the United States.

Please call to make an appointment to stop by and visit with the volunteers, and take advantage of this very valuable resource. We can guarantee you will learn something and have fun!

There are three new USPS Stamps to be issued in April/May 2018 *



U.S. Airmail Army Pilots Stamp

Release Date: May 1 | Washington DC | PSA pane of 20

The airmail stamp being issued on May 1 in Washington, D.C., to commemorate the 100th anniversary of the beginning of regular airmail service will be the first of two identical design stamps to be issued this year. This first stamp in blue commemorates the pioneering spirit of the brave Army pilots who initiated the world's first regularly scheduled airmail service. An identical stamp, printed in red, will be issued later this summer to commemorate the beginning of airmail delivery through the U.S. Post Office Department, which began in August 1918.

Editors Note: "The stamps are being printed and processed in panes of 20 by USPS contract printer Ashton Potter. The print run is particularly small for a modern U.S. commemorative, at just 7.5 million stamps, or 375,000 panes of 20. Some local post offices might not have the new stamp on hand, because the Postal Service will not make an automatic push distribution of this issue to post offices. That means the post office won't receive the new stamp unless it places an order for it with USPS Stamp Fulfillment Services."**

Sally Ride Stamp

Release Date: May 23 | La Jolla, CA | Format TBD

America's first woman in space, Sally Ride was a member of the crew of Space Shuttle Challenger STS-7 in 1984. She inspired the nation as a pioneering astronaut, brilliant physicist and dedicated educator, and was awarded the Presidential Medal of Freedom in 2013. Sally Ride was born May 26, 1951 in Encino, Ca. and died July 23, 2012 in La Jolla. The official release site for the stamp is La Jolla.
