## Member Spotlight!



The Poway Stamp Club Newsletter highlights one of its members each issue. Today's spotlight is on **Daniel Klein**.

**Daniel Klein** appreciates the peacefulness and deep relaxing satisfaction of stamp collecting. He has special reasons to cherish being member #405 of the Poway Stamp Club.

Daniel collects Germany, Switzerland, Palestine, Israel and USA...these are all the countries he lived in from the 1937 to 1990 enroute to his beloved final home in San Diego.

In the 1930s Daniel was a young boy growing up in Palestine after his family had to flee Germany. His father had lived in Germany and was an avid stamp collector...with stamps and covers in an ordinary interesting collection...accumulated over many years. The collection was his father's pride and joy. It was not overly valuable but it had a few better covers and certain stamps that took years for his dad to find. It brought a sense of pride, wonderful peacefulness, deep relaxation, and satisfaction to his father...until one night when NAZI thugs in a KRISTALLNACHT (German for "Broken Glass") operation broke into his house and TOOK the collection and BURNED it along with all other household valuables.

Ask Daniel about his life saving epic journey out of Palestine from the 1937 to 1990 when he finally arrived in San Diego as a US Green Card holder. Now DANIEL KLEIN enjoys the everyday peacefulness and relaxation and ordinary pride of being a stamp collector and a member of the Poway Stamp Club.

**STEM Education** Release Date: Friday, April 6, 2018  
11:00 A.M. EDT



These Forever stamps celebrate the role of science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) education in keeping our nation a global leader in innovation. Designed to pique the curiosity of the viewer, each of these four stamps features a collage of faces, symbols, drawings and numbers that represent the complexity and interconnectedness of the STEM disciplines.

**Peace Rose** Release Date: Saturday, April 21, 2018  
11:00 A.M. CDT



Peace Rose celebrates one of the most popular roses of all time. The peace rose revolutionized hybrid tea roses with its unique coloring, hardiness, and disease resistance.
