2022-3	To eliminate the age requirement in part (a) of Section 14.260 for life membership	PASSED

2022-5 To provide the Grand Exalted Ruler with the ability to protect members, guests and Property when a member acts or threatens to act in an egregious manner (Yes = 2,346 / No = 334).

2022-6 The purpose of this amendment is to clarify that there is no charge for the issuance **PASSED** of identification cards (Yes = 2,542 / No = 143).

2022-7 The purpose of this amendment is to ensure that the Grand Exalted Ruler has sufficient time to analyze the objections made by a member, Lodge or State Association that are subject to an executive order (Yes = 2,605 / No = 85).

2022-8 The purpose of this amendment is to provide authority for the local Lodge Commit-**PASSED** tees and Subcommittees to meet by electronic means (Yes = 2,409 / No = 275).


2022-9 The purpose of this amendment is to authorize the Grand Exalted Ruler or the District Deputy to allow electronic meetings to protect members from serious threat to their health and safety and to ensure the continuation of Lodge business (Yes = 2,450 / No = 236).

2022-10 The purpose of this amendment is to clarify that an unaffiliated member, who is the current spouse of a Member, may visit a Lodge and attend events of the Order in a manner consistent with the status of a spouse who has never been a Member of the Order (Yes = 2,173 / No = 506).

2022-11 The purpose of this amendment is to authorize electronic submittal of forms in the **PASSED** permitting process from the Board of Grand Trustees (Yes = 2,602 / No = 73).

Our new Grand Exalted Ruler for the 2022-23 year is Bruce A. Hidley, of Watervliet-Colonie, NY Elks Lodge No. 1500. He spoke about his vision for the Order, encompassed in his theme: "PROMOTING ELKDOM WITH ENTHUSIASM"! He asked that each member grow membership by 2 new members this year. This is at the top of his list of priorities for the Elks. We also need to promote our Tarentum Lodge No. 644 for the good work throughout our community.
