- Scholarships are available only to students who enroll in four-year undergraduate progams at accredited colleges.

Proceeds from the sales this year will support the *Alle-Kiski Area Hope Center*. Their mission is to offer supportive services, opportunities for healing and community education to assist victims and end violence and abuse.
