It's that time of year! We are looking for the next group of dedicated members to **join our Chapter's Board of Directors**. Available Roles & Description Beginning January 2027:

- **Chapter President (Elected):** Directs overall chapter operations by leading all chapter and board meetings, proposing strategic initiatives for the group's success, appointing and conferring with committee chairs, and acting as a voting member on all committees except the nominating committee
- **1st Vice President (Elected):** Serves as the primary successor and backup for

the presidency, which includes acting as parliamentarian, running meetings when the President is absent, taking over the role if a vacancy occurs, and assisting the president with special tasks as assigned

- **Treasurer (Elected):** Oversees the financial health of the chapter by collecting annual dues, paying authorized expenses, keeping records open for board inspection, and maintaining signature authority over the bank account
- **Director of Membership (Appointed):** Spearheads growth and retention efforts by chairing the membership committee, maintaining an up-to-date chapter roster with MOAA national, ensuring all officers hold national membership, and partnering with the Treasurer to track dues

- **October:** The nominees for next year's board will be shared with the general membership via email
- **November 12th:** Official voting by the full membership body

July 1st, California Legislative Veterans Caucus celebrates America's 250th at Capitol Hill, Sacramento, CA

Legislative Update

It's July which is quiet time for California legislation. The California Assembly and Senate are on recess and the legislators are home. Much was accomplished by the end of June, all four bills which are important to Veterans passed the first house, passed all policy committee hearings, and are now in the Appropriations Committee awaiting a final hearing and referral to the floor for final passage in August. The best way you can encourage passage of these bills is to send an email or letter of support. For [SB 1407](#) *Personal Income Tax \$40,000 exclusion*, [SB 888](#) *exclude DIC from income for property tax deduction*, and [SB 296](#) *100% disabled veteran 50%/100% property tax exclusions*. Email the Assembly Appropriations Committee approps.committee@assembly.ca.gov. To advocate for [AB 2022](#) *Property taxation: exemption: 100% disabled veteran homeowners*, which is comparable to SB 296, deliver a message to Aisha Wahab <https://sd10.senate.ca.gov/contact> who represent voters in Alameda County and is member of the Appropriations Committee.

With nothing new, this is a good time to give you an example of how California legislature works. In February 2025, [Senator Bob Archuleta](#) introduced **SB-623 Veterans' Bond** to allow a veteran to receive both homeowners and disabled Veterans property tax exemption. The bill was sent for committee hearings and stayed there for all of 2025. In the last ten days of January 2026, the bill raced through all committee hearings and passed the Assembly. If a bill does not pass by the end of January of the second year of legislature it is dead. Nothing more happened until May when it was finally referred to committees for hearings and then withdrawn. In mid-June, during the budget battles someone decided it was a good time to ask the voters for \$1.15 million for CALVet. **SB 623** was amended in process referred to gut and replace. It became **SB 623 Veterans Bond Act of 2026**. Immediately after the bill passed its hearing, the entire bill was added to a \$10 million affordable housing bill **SB 417** to become the *Veterans and Affordable Housing Bond Act of 2026*. This was passed by both houses and signed by Governor Newsom

in 2 days, the last day to get it on the November ballot. It will appear as Proposition 1. Finally **SB 623** was completely amended to have nothing to do with Veterans. It became the **SB 623 *Automobile Accidents: Civil Actions: Transportation Network Companies***, which is an agreement between Uber and Consumer Attorneys limiting claims for accident damages and to withdraw two competing initiatives from the November ballot.

The lesson is that through manipulation of the legislative system Archuleta enabled \$10 million in affordable housing bonds, a rideshare liability agreement, and hopefully the support needed to pass **SB 888** and **SB 296**.

We are in the middle of summer and it's the time of year that many families and military members travel. So have you tried or thought about going somewhere on military Space-A travel? Military Space Available (Space-A) travel allows authorized passengers to occupy Department of Defense (DoD) aircraft seats that are surplus after all Space Required (Space-R) passengers have been accommodated. Space-A travel costs nothing but is allowed only on a non-mission interference basis.

For Space-A military flights near the SF Bay Area, your primary departure hub is Travis Air Force Base in Fairfield, CA. Flights go to Hawaii, Japan, Guam and more.

Ramstein Air Base in Germany is now the most accessible Space-A destination in Europe. The rotator from BWI to this base continues to operate one or two times per week, and several east coast bases have regular cargo missions there.

As of March 26, 2026, the new AMC Travel Self-Signup Tool for Space-A & Space-R Travel is now live for all AMC locations: <https://gatesea.mtmc.gov/amctravel/>

NOTE: Space-A seats are normally identified as early as 3-4 hours and as late as 30 minutes prior to departure. Recommend you check with the passenger service center for the space available show time for your flight prior to departing the terminal. Be ready for immediate processing and boarding.

Eligibility

A complete listing of eligible passengers by category is contained in DoDI 4515.13.

Membership in National MOAA

Rudolf Bredderman - Acting Membership

According to our Chapter roster in the national MOAA database, all our 2026 members who are eligible for national MOAA membership are members of MOAA at the national level except for one of our newest Active-Duty members. Forty-two are LIFE members and 8 are Premium members at the national level. Ten (including 4 Active-Duty Members) of our Chapter members are “Basic” members of MOAA at the national level. MOAA is encouraging all “Basic” members to become either “Premium” or “LIFE” members, i.e., dues paying members.

It is important that Chapter members who are Premium (Annual) members of national MOAA keep their national MOAA membership current with the payment of annual dues; or upgrade to “LIFE” membership in national MOAA.

Please visit the national MOAA website <https://www.moaa.org> . It provides current information of significance to military personnel, active, former and retired and to spouses of military personnel; and it is easy to navigate. Access to much of the MOAA website requires logging in as a MOAA member. To do so, you will need to enter your MOAA membership number, and you will have to create a password. Life Membership: LIFE membership costs vary from \$921 for someone 49 years old or less to \$107 if you are 95 to 99 years old. If you are over 100, LIFE Membership is FREE. LIFE membership passes to your spouse if you predecease your spouse.
