Coined as "The Empress of Opulence," Raven Rose is an award winning Afro-Indigenous dancer known for her grace, glamour, and grind. This "Sapphic Sensation" is a GLAMbassador for the LGBTQ+ family and hosts shows to raise money for the community as well as other causes. In 2016 she began the production of variety shows, The Raven's Nest and Max-TEASE, including not only burlesque, but also drag, sideshow, and circus arts. Raven is the 2025 winner of Texas' Alamo City Tease, and Denver's "Most High," making Black and Indigenous burlesque history as the first performer from Arkansas to hold a prestigious burlesque Oueen title. When not performing and teaching burlesque related workshops all over the country, she is choreographing steamy group and solo acts for other performers along with creating glamorous costumes for show ponies under her costume line "Risk by Raven."

Mari Allen Burbank is a multi-hyphenate creative (producer/ director/ performer/designer), educator, and artivist. They hail from Little Rock, AR, but have directed, performed, and taught around the country. Mari is also the Co-Founder and Producing Artistic Director of Actors Theatre of Little Rock. Mari is no stranger to the stage having over 80 production credits ranging from community, education, and professional productions. Previously, they were the Associate Artistic Director and Executive Director of The Studio Theatre, where they have directed and produced eleven productions, including Songs for a New World, Mamma Mia, A Christmas Story: the musical, and Dogfight. Other directing projects include Parade and Mary Poppins at the Royal Theatre, Young Frankenstein with the Community Theatre of Little Rock, and Johnny Appleseed with Missoula Children's Theatre. Mari spent the covid year teaching theatre at Little Rock Central High School, and has taught classes and workshops in acting, dance, singing, and auditioning with schools and theaters around the country. Mari is also an accomplished designer, choreographer, musical director, and actor. Favorite acting credits include Tony (West Side Story), Squidward (The Spongebob Musical), Anthony (Sweeney Todd), Prince Dauntless (Once Upon A Mattress), Jeffery (Godspell), Prince Topher (Cinderella), Enjolras (Les Miserables), and Rolf (The Sound of Music). Mari is a graduate of the University of Central Arkansas.


