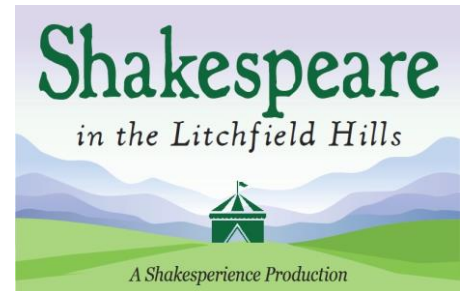
Shakespeare-a-thon, April
