Shakespeare in the Litchfield Hills is an immersive community event culminating in five free family-friendly outdoor "Shakespeare in the Park" presentations featuring professional Equity actors.





This humanities-based project encompasses history, the arts, and communication, focusing on inter-generational storytelling. It includes stories of eighteen Neighborhoods, along with twenty additional personal narratives adapted into creative scenes of individuals and communities within the Greater Waterbury area. Shakesperience partners with stake-holders to create this highquality, sustainable arts program wherein young people, older adults, and professional teachers, actors, and directors rehearse performances that focus on the development and history of specific Waterbury neighborhoods.

Acting Classes

Shakesperience proudly offers Saturday Classes in our Waterbury Studio and beyond. 7-week sessions in winter, spring, and fall, with week long sessions in summer are available. Professional resident artists instruct students aged 7 to 17 in the Shakesperience Approach. Students learn to develop action and character through text within a strong, socially responsive ensemble that takes ownership of the work. Participants show significant long-term behaviors, including literacy, public speaking, individual and group work ethic, and positive outlook, attitude, and self-expression.

El Barrio! Folklore Workshop

Based on our Folklore Workshop, El Barrio explores Folklore from Latin American cultures. Starting with all Puerto Rican stories in 2023, we have since added folktales from Mexico and Brazil. Students perform alongside Shakesperience actors in various folktale scenes that will capture the hearts and minds of students. **Grades 2-6**
