HOURS OF OPERATION ARE 9 AM TO DUSK

MEETINGS ARE HELD 2ND AND 4TH Tuesdays OF THE MONTH AT THE INDOOR RANGE AT 7 P.M.

- GATE RULES (USE SILVER COMBINATION LOCK):
 - SHUT AND LOCK GATE WHEN YOU ENTER AND WHEN YOU LEAVE UNLESS IT IS PUBLIC EVENT.
 - DO NOT GIVE OUT THE GATE CODE TO ANYONE, EVEN IF THEY ARE MEMBERS!
- NO GUESTS AT THE OUTDOOR RANGE UNLESS YOU HAVE A GUEST PASS!
- MEMBERSHIP CARDS AND GUESTS PASSES MUST BE ON YOU AND VISIBLE AT ALL TIMES.
 - o If asked for your Membership/Guest Pass, and cannot produce it, you will be asked to leave.
- NO TRASH IS TO BE LEFT BEHIND! If it doesn't fit in the garbage cans, stop at the Indoor Range dumpster.
- MEMBERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR TAKING THEIR OWN TARGETS AND TARGET STANDS/HOLDERS.
- WATER BRIDGE: If there is high water, water or ice covering, or debris on the bridge, DO NOT STAY!
- STEEL TARGETS: 25 YARDS FROM BENCHES AT RIFLE RANGE; 10 YARDS ON PISTOL RANGE
- NO drug/alcohol use during or prior to the use of the range
- NO exploding targets of ANY type (partial list: no Tannerite, no glass, no tv's, no clays, no CANNONS!)
- NO TARGETS on the hillside, trees, or fenceposts! USE YOUR TARGETS STANDS!
- NO fully automatic firearms
- NO shooting outside the range limits
- NO shooting toward benches/seating areas on either range
- NO crossfire EVER!
- NO ATV USE / NO HUNTING ON CLUB PROPERTY!
- SURVEILLANCE PRACTICES IN PLACE; FOLLOW ALL FIREARM SAFETY RULES! BE COURTEOUS TO ALL!

REQUIRED SAFETY

- Eye and ear protection at all times
- Keep mussle pointed in a safe direction at all times
- Unload/show clear when firearm not in use
- No handling of firearm(s) at any tie when someone is down range
- Use proper ammunition for your firearm!
- If you witness unsafe behavior, report it to the mrapc executive committee and/or law enforcement.

Guest Pass Authorization and Procedure

(This amendment to the Outdoor Range Access/Range Rules was voted on and passed on February 26, 2019)

The Moundsville Rifle & Pistol Club GUEST PASS is <u>only available to MEMBER-SPONSORED AUTHORIZED</u> <u>GUESTS</u>. Failure to follow all the MRAPC Range Rules, including those specifically for Guest Access, could result in disciplinary action for the MRAPC Member. Such actions may include loss of privileges and/or loss of membership.

- GUEST PASS \$5.00 per person, PER DAY
- An ACTIVE/CURRENT MRAPC Member must sponsor each Guest
- Limited to THREE (3) Guest Passes per Sponsoring Member at one time
- Advanced Signup only at least 48 hours notice. <u>NO CALLS AFTER</u> 6pm or on weekends
 - Mondays & Thursdays from 6pm 9pm are the best times to stop in and register for a pass.
 - O There are also some weekend events that will allow for Members to register for a Guest pass.
- Sponsoring Member(s) are NOT PERMITTED to give any Guest the passcode for the outdoor gate.
- Guest(s) must remain with MRAPC Member at all times while on property
- The authorized Guest lanyard/pass must be visible on the guest's person at all times while on property
- Guest(s) are required to follow all MRAPC Range & Safety Rules.
- Guest(s) and Member(s) acknowledge that use of the outdoor range is at their own risk.
- All GUEST PASSES must be turned in by the date given to the Sponsoring Member at the time of signout. (You have a due date.)

AMENDMENTS TO RULES

- Outdoor Rifle Range Amended 06/11/2019
 - ALL TARGETS WITHIN 25 YARDS from the bench MUST have the bottom of the target a MINIMUM of 2 FEET OFF THE GROUND
 - (Please note, this does NOT change the existing rule regarding steel targets at the rifle range. It still reads: NO steel targets less than 25 yards from benches on rifle range.)
