Secretary's Report

• Willow motioned to accept the last General PTO meeting minutes (4/10/24), seconded by Diana, and approved by all.

Treasurer - Financial report

- Marie provided the treasurer report.
- The PTO bank account at the end of April 2024 was \$9,790.48.
- Current PTO bank account balance per Marie's report was \$6,987.10, but Prudence had just deposited a \$1,500.00 scholarship donation, so the current balance as of today is \$8,487.10.

New Business:

- Fundraising opportunity:
 - Jason from Step it Up spoke to the PTO about a fundraising opportunity for next school year.
 - Step it Up helped Crismon HS earn \$15,000.00.
 - Step it Up does 90% of the work, they just need to work with one PTO committee member.
 - They distribute a "golden ticket" to students and teachers show a 6 minute video in class to students.
 - Each student gets their own link and children send emails to family and friends.
 - Every child that registers and sends 10 + emails gets two prizes, one of which is a LED light.
 - Step it Up gives away 2-3 prizes every day of the fundraising event which lasts about two weeks.
 - They display a thermometer on the website that increases as donations come in.
 - Jason stated 80% of the money raised comes in from Venmo and Apple Pay.
 - When people donate they get an automated report.
 - 90% of the funds raised are from outside the school community.
 - They can advertise that the funds are being raised just for the PTO.
 - EHS gets 60% of all the money raised, the other 40% goes to Step it Up for prizes and other overhead costs.
 - All donations are made out to the PTO, so donations are tax deductible.
 - The PTO gets a finalized donor report that we can download.
