# **New Business**

#### • President:

- T-Shirt update/future order:
  - The PTO purchased T-shirts and hats, and with recent sales we have almost recouped the purchase price.
  - PTO is considering ordering some additional gray and blue tie-dye
    T-shirts to sell before the Eastmark Back to School event.

#### • Sponsorship and Volunteer Opportunities:

- Jamie is reaching out to past sponsors to ask if they would be willing to sponsor again this school year.

#### All Staff lunches:

- The number of teachers at EHS has increased this school year and with inflation the cost of the All Staff lunches has increased to \$800.00 to \$1,000.00 a lunch. Due to this increase, lunches may have to be held once a quarter instead of once a month, it will depend on the amount of sponsors we receive.
- A sponsor can provide the full amount of a lunch, or we can try to get multiple sponsors for a lunch (splitting the cost among multiple sponsors).
