Secretary's Report

 Willow motioned to accept the last General PTO meeting minutes (8/9/23), seconded by Diana, and approved by all.

Treasurer - Financial report

- Malisa provided the treasurer report.
- PTO bank account at the end of August was \$11,922.01.
- PTO bank account as of 9/13/23 is \$11,869.10.
- There is \$65.00 in Venmo which will be included in next month's balance.

New Business

• Principal:

o <u>Homecoming events:</u>

- Currently planning homecoming activities, something each day.
- Thursday afterschool, at 5:30 pm there is an off campus parade starting on Copernicus Road, going through the neighborhood and ending at the football field.
- Movie night on the baseball field, the older Charlie and the Chocolate Factory movie.
- Football game Friday night
- Dance on Saturday
- Guillermo suggested getting the parade route on social media asap.

o **Bond Presentation**:

- On November Ballot
- Asking for \$98 million for projects over 5 years, including security, new buses, and renovations.
- Vote on the 15% budget override
- Please confirm you are registered to vote
- EHS currently has 4 lunches and would like to reduce to 2.
- We currently have 5 baseball teams and one field; JV teams play home games at Queen Creek High School.

- We just want to complete the master build plan from 5 years ago.
- We have grown 88% over the last 5 years.
- With growth, in the future, Copernicus Road would need to be widened from Point Twenty-Two to Ray Road.
- A traffic light is needed at the student parking lot.
- The dirt lot will need to be paved for additional student parking spots.
- Use of bond money at EHS:
 - Admin area with cafeteria & learning stairs
 - Gym
 - Classrooms
 - Multi-use field with track
 - Baseball field
 - Softball field
 - Practice field
 - Tennis courts
 - Outdoor dining
 - Turf field
 - Additional parking

o Graduation:

- 23% larger this year than last year
- We might outgrow our stadium
- We could hold graduation at ASU
- The principal does not want to limit the number of seats per graduate.
- Last year EHS used the dirt lot for parking, this year it is under construction.
- We may have to consider having visitors park at nearby elementary schools and shuttle them to EHS for the graduation ceremony.

• President:
