

Pigeon Flowering Kale

- Plant in Sun (at least 6 hrs of sun)
- Grows 8-12" (20-30cm) tall by 12-14" (30-36cm) wide
- A unique ornamental kale for garden landscapes and combination planters that almost looks like large roses.
 Compact, dwarf plants with uniform, round shaped, solid heads and slightly wavy leaves. Compact, small-leafed series is frost tolerant.
- Heads begin to display colors on the plant's central leaves when the air temperature consistently falls below 55-60° F.




Floral Lace™ Dianthus

- Plant in Sun (at least 6 hrs of sun)
- Space 8-10" (20-25cm) apart
- Grows 8-10" (20-25cm) tall by 8" (20cm) wide
- · Shows off extra-large, lacy-edged flowers. Grows well in tough conditions as an annual or biennial.
- · Performs best in cool weather.



Spring Matrix™ Pansy

- Plant in Partial Sun, Sun
- · Space 6-8" (15-20cm) apart
- Grows 8" (20cm) tall by 8-10" (20-25cm) wide
- · Large, thick-petaled, 3-in./8-cm flowers are held beautifully over the foliage on strong, sturdy stems. Produces more flowers per plant than other pansies to create high-impact landscapes and containers.
- Plant in full to partial sun in early Spring or Fall for best performance. In some climates, pansies planted in Fall will overwinter and rebloom the next Spring.



Delta Pro Pansy

Plant in Partial Sun, Sun

by 6-8" (15-20cm) wide

- Grows 4-6" (10-15cm) tall
- Short flower stems hold large flowers upward, providing long-lasting and impactful color to your pots and gardens. Compact and heavily branched plants fill pots quickly.
- · Plants need at least 4 to 6 hours of sun to produce lots of blooms. Water regularly but be careful—overwatering can create root problems. Pansies thrive in soil rich in organic matter. For pots, choose a soil mix specifically for containers.



Matrix[®] Pansy

- Plant in Partial Sun, Sun
- · Space 8" (20cm) apart
- Grows 8" (20cm) tall by 8-10" (20-25cm) wide
- · Extra-large flowers on strong, sturdy stems. Produces more flowers per plant than other pansies to create high-impact landscapes and containers.
- · Plant in full to partial sun in early Spring or Fall for best flowering. In some climates, pansies planted in Fall will overwinter and rebloom the next Spring.



Majestic Giants II Pansy

- Plant in Partial Sun. Sun
- Space 7-8" (18-20cm) apart
- Grows 8" (20cm) tall by 10" (25cm) wide
- Maintains extra-large flower size under warm conditions with excellent overwintering and rebloom in the spring. Blooms show a contrasting dark "face."
- · Plants need at least 4 to 6 hours of sun to produce lots of blooms. Water regularly but be careful—overwatering can create root problems. Pansies thrive in soil rich in organic matter. For pots. choose a soil mix specifically for containers.

Sorbet® XP Viola

- Plant in Partial Sun, Sun
- Space 6" (15cm) apart
- Grows 6-8" (15-20cm) tall by 6-8" (15-20cm) wide
- Early-blooming, free-flowering plants remain compact in both heat and cold and have excellent overwintering ability.
- Plant in full to partial sun in early Spring or Fall for best flowering. In some climates, violas planted in Fall will overwinter and rebloom the next Spring.



Penny Viola

- Plant in Partial Sun, Sun
- Grows 4-6" (10-15cm) tall by 4-6" (10-15cm) wide
- Early-flowering violas display 1-in. (2.5cm) blooms. Excellent cool weather tolerance.
- Violas grow best during cooler weather in full sun; warmer weather in partial shade. Plant after the last spring frost and again in the fall. Water regularly; do not let flowers dry out. Deadhead spent flowers to encourage fresh blooms. Cut back violas in the early fall to rejuvenate the plant and encourage additional blooming.
