The Guide.

- ⦿ Progress is built on tiny reps. Train one small criterion at a time.
- ⦿ Keep sessions short and generalize across many locations.
- ⦿ When in doubt, lower the difficulty and generously reward the behavior you want.

Training Expectations.

Handler Commitments.

- ① Daily practice: 2–3 short sessions (5–10 min), one skill at a time; log reps; never raise duration, distance, and distraction at the same time.
- ② Humane methods & management: reward-based training, clear cues or markers, ample rest with potty breaks and repetition exercises; end on success and decompress.
- ③ Public advocacy: create space, decline greetings when needed, and maintain calm, consistent expectations in every environment.

Dog Performance Goals.

- ① Public conduct: under control, housebroken, quiet; settles at handler's feet/under table; neutral to food, people, and other dogs.
- ② Task reliability: performs trained task(s) on cue or when needed with ≤ 3 -second latency, ≥ 85 –90% reliability in 3+ locations; no nuisance/false alerts.
- ③ Manners & resilience: loose-leash with halts/turns, down-stay 10–30 minutes with moderate distractions, quick recovery from startle.

ADA Essentials

Details

- A Service Dog is individually trained to perform work or tasks directly related to a disability.
- The ADA does not create or recognize any national registry for service dogs.
- Avoid paid registries or ID schemes that claim they provide a legal status, as they are not necessary and not recognized by law.
- Business may only ask two questions upon entering their store:
 - Is the dog a service animal?
 - What work or task is it trained to perform?

- This is to ensure your service dog is trained to uphold Pubic Access Standard qualifications.
