Registration will be 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. You will pick up your registration packet at that time. **The luncheon (Badge Required)** speaker is going to be **Les Rowe**. His topic is **Fenton Liquor Decanters from the 1930's**. He is a member of the Stretch Glass Society and a charter member of the National Fenton Glass Society. He has served on the board of the NFGS for more than 25 years. He has served as the Finance Chairman, whose duties include purchasing glass for the club and being in charge of glass sales, as well as Vice-President and President several times. He and his wife Roxanne started collecting Stretch Glass in the late 1980's followed by the crested lines Fenton had to offer. Over the years, their collection has evolved into many other areas.

Set up will be Thursday evening after Glass ID or on Friday at 7:00 am to 9:00 am in main Display room. For security purposes, plan to turn in a list of your display glass before your display is set up.
