We care for an average of 23 kids, ages preschool to seventeen. We provide refuge and shelter for children in need.

The Start of Casa de mi Padre

In 2010, Shane Sanderson founded the Casa de mi Padre children's home as a ministry of Child Rescue. In 2025, the organization became Child Rescue International Inc.

Our mission is still to provide refuge and shelter for needy children coming from shattered homes, neglect, abandonment, or abuse, or who are orphaned through death. As our ministry has matured, we are now poised to be able to send some of our young people out on their own missionary journeys, and if the Lord wills, to spread the Gospel internationally.

In 2026, Cole and Sarah McCauley became Directors of Casa de mi Padre. Shane stepped into his new role of Director Emeritus and continues actively serving and leading mission trips.

Advance Program:

When our young people leave the children's home at 18, we continue assisting them, just as any parent would, until they are independent.



Heart for Missions:

We teach our kids to be "on mission" wherever the Lord calls them. We believe God is preparing some to serve internationally.

Where in the World?

Casa de mi Padre is located in Santa Cruz del Quiché, Guatemala. Poverty is widespread throughout the countryside and inner city areas.

Illiteracy, infant mortality, and malnutrition are among the highest in the region, while life expectancy is the lowest. The Quiche people are an Indigenous group who have limited education and resources.
