- ~ Special needs for kids such as braces, Christmas, some other medical costs
- ~ Education for some ADVANCE program young adults.

We are also praying to raise funds to help complete the construction of the permanent Casa de Mi Padre by building 2 family-sized homes averaging around \$200,000 each. We are trusting the Lord to continue touching people's hearts and providing for our mission work through monthly donations or one-time gifts as He faithfully has in all our years of serving here.

Our orphanage is located in Santa Cruz del Quiché, Guatemala, Central America. Although the country of Guatemala is ecologically beautiful, poverty is particularly wide spread throughout the countryside and large intercity areas. Illiteracy, infant mortality, and malnutrition are among the highest in the region, while life expectancy is the lowest. The Quiché people are an indigenous group who have limited education and resources. The population of the city of Santa Cruz is between 45 and 55 thousand people. The opportunity for ministry is vast and the need for orphan care in Santa Cruz, the district of Quiché, and the surrounding region is real.

CHILD RESCUE - CASA DE MI PADRE

As a distinctly Christian orphanage, we seek to help our kids overcome the hurts in their past through the transforming power of the gospel. Our prayer is that the children and young people we care for will come to know the love of God, accept salvation through Christ, and be empowered by the Holy Spirit with a strong Christian witness to others.

CHILDREN'S HOME:

The ministry of Child Rescue is to provide refuge and shelter for needy children coming from poverty, shattered homes, abandonment, or children orphaned through death. Child Rescue meets the physical needs of children in order to have the opportunity to then meet their emotional and spiritual needs. We usually have about 23 kids ages preschool to 17 living in our children's home.

ADVANCE PROGRAM:

When the young people we serve turn 18 and have to leave the children's home, they can choose to continue receiving our help to finish their education. We also help them with their housing and living expenses. This program is serving 10 young men and women. Over the past several years, we have had various students from the program living with our family.

We continue to fund our youths' education after age 18 when they leave Casa.

MISSIONS:

We seek to glorify God by sharing His love with others in word and deed. Kids from Casa participate in our weekly Bible quizzing program along with other youth in the area, as well as camps and retreats. We also host missions groups from the USA for mission trips to serve at the orphanage or to help with the construction of our new orphanage site. More details are on our website.
