Hello, I'm Ruben. I would like to share a little about what has happened in my life recently. I moved out of Casa de Mi Padre home at the beginning of 2020. It has been an experience with ups and downs, but God has shown his mercy and love in my life in different ways. Sometimes we have and make plans for our

lives, but God's plans are better than ours. This reminds me of the verse in Isaiah 55:8 that says. "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are your ways my ways, says the Lord." I want to share a little of what happened to me this year. A few months ago, I had plans to go do an internship in Spain since I finished university at the end of the year. I had made my plans and was already getting my papers ready. I felt excited for a new stage in my life. I was going to be gone for approximately 6 months. Over the course of this time, it had been difficult since I did not have a stable job and I was

having a hard time supporting myself financially. There were times when I was working, then there were times with no work and I was left without money. But God continued to be faithful in difficult times. Every morning in my devotions, I prayed to God to provide me with a job. I went to seeveral job interviews, but they always told me that because I was studying they couldn't give me the job due to schedule availability.

I spent almost a year looking for formal employment, but it didn't happen, so I gave up and continued working where I was, when there was work. I started making my plans to leave next year. But I felt that it was not the time and that leaving the country very young and alone was a risk since it was another country, culture, and many other things. I kept praying to God that if his plans were not for me to leave the country, he would provide me with a job. I felt somewhat discouraged because it was being difficult financially.

At the beginning of August of this year, I decided to start applying again. I started sending my paperwork but they didn't call me, and if they did it was to tell me to come back when I finished my studies. But I didn't give up. There was a job fair, I got my paperwork ready, and I went hoping to stay in Guatemala. But it didn't happen, they just told me that it was the type of profile they were looking for, but I would return at the end of the year when school was over. So that time I returned home very sad and gave up. I remember going into the house with the family I live with, and I told them that I couldn't stay. They told me to rest assured that God was going to provide a job. I entered my room and I felt somewhat discouraged and sad. In the afternoon, a friend of Casa de Mi Padre and a sister in Christ, who knew me from Casa since I was little contacted me. Her name is Gloria. She writes to me telling me that she works for CEMACO in the Capital. And wondered if I was interested in a job, and I told her yes! That message was the beginning of God's response to my life. I sent them my paperwork, but after a week they didn't call me so for a moment I thought it was going to be as usual. But it wasn't like that! They contacted me, I started doing the interviews, and then I had to go to Guatemala to take a pen test. I was a bit nervous, but I went. It was difficult to take the test since it was my first time, so I returned home somewhat thoughtful since I was not so sure that I would pass the test. It took a few days when I thought they weren't going to

call me so I just waited. I remember well when the human resources person wrote to me telling me that I had passed the test and that I had to go to the capital to sign the contract! I almost cried with emotion and, all excited, I went and told the family I live with. It was God's answer so I wouldn't leave the country next year.

Now I am working for CEMACO [a



big furniture and home goods company with many stores]. And I understood that God's plans are perfect and that, in the least expected moments, God uses circumstances and people to show the plans that God has for our lives. So I told my pastor, and he told me that he also thought it was a risk to leave too young because of the influence of the world. And I was glad I stayed.

I currently serve the church in the youth ministry, and my pastor told me that God wants to continue using my skills and talents

for his service. And now I know that God will also use my finances for his glory. And maybe in a few years I can go do my internship. I'm just excited about what God will continue to do.

Thank you to everyone who is and was part of my spiritual growth, your prayers, your words of encouragement as well as your financial support to be where I am now. Glory, honor, and praise be to God.

We praise God because this is actually the second time this past year where Ruben had a big decision to make and took it to the Lord. He is growing up well, Praise the King, and keep Praying for Ruben along with praying for everyone in our home! Well, that's all for now; please continue to petition on our behalf!
