"Training the Next Generation with a Pure Heart and Good Conscience" (1 Timothy 1:5; 4:12)

As we approach the end of another year, our hearts are full of gratitude for what God continues to do at Casa de mi Padre. The Word of God is truly being hidden in their hearts—and we're seeing it shape the way they speak, forgive, and help each other every day. These small victories remind us that training in godliness has value for all things (1 Timothy 4:8).



School Update: Building Minds and Character



Our school, Robles de Justicia ("Oaks of Righteousness"), continues to grow stronger academically, spiritually, and relationally. This year, we welcomed a few new teachers who share our vision for education rooted in truth and grace. Here in Guatemala, the school year is from January to October, and we are proud to say that all our children passed their grades this year!

Beyond math, grammar, and the usual subjects, our children explored cooking, candle-making, violin, piano, Greek, reading, and an evangelical catechism. Each of these subjects has become another way to cultivate creativity, discipline, and a love for learning.

Please pray with us as we prepare for the next school year—that every classroom would remain a place where both knowledge and character take deep root, and where Christ is honored in all we do.



Claudia's Story — God's Provision and Perfect Timing

Claudia has worked alongside us in our school for over 13 years and has been a phenomenal part of Casa de Mi Padre. She's a woman of God who loves the children as her own, teaching them Scripture and naturally discipling them day by day. When recent government changes required us to restructure our school and hire a full-time psychologist—educator starting in the 2026 school year, Claudia could no longer continue as our school director. It was hard for all of us—she's one of the best teachers and mentors we've ever had.



At our graduation ceremony earlier this month, as we honored Claudia for her years of faithful service, I felt a deep conviction that this couldn't be the end of her ministry here. Later that evening, we sat together in my office, prayed, and talked about a possible new role—helping with administration while continuing to disciple the children she loves so deeply. Claudia smiled and said she'd love that, especially since her degree is actually in administration. She also mentioned that she would like to set up some discipleship times with the young adults in our Advance Program. At the time, we didn't have the financial means to make it happen—but we knew that if God wanted it, *He would provide*...

The very next morning, while meeting with a missions group from the USA that was visiting for the week, two friends on the missions team—Lacey and Robin—unexpectedly asked how much it would cost to keep Claudia serving the children. They offered to cover it on the spot. I was stunned. I told them we had *just* prayed about that the night before. They immediately offered to split the cost so Claudia could stay on our staff.

It was one of those unmistakable moments where God made His will clear. He wants Claudia here—continuing to pour truth and love into these children. Over the past couple of years, we have been crying out

that God would send more people to serve in our mission work here as we strive to share the gospel with the kids at Casa de Mi Padre and the young adults in our Advance Program. We sometimes feel like we are stretched so thin with all of our responsibilities that we just don't have enough time to dedicate to discipling all these young people as we would like to. Originally, we thought maybe God would send another missionary from the USA to help. What humbles me most is that He is raising up Guatemalan believers to do it-people who love these children as their own, carrying the same heart that God placed in us.
