

FAQ - WHEN IS IT?

Show Day: Sunday, June
1st

No rehearsals/pictures on May 26 (Memorial Day).

We have two shows — your dancer's assigned show TBD!

Show times 1:30pm & 4:30pm!

Dress rehearsal schedule is TBD

Dancers will most likely NOT have dress rehearsals at the theatre but will have instudio rehearsals and a theatre tour.

FAQ - WHEN AND HOW DO WE GET TICKETS?

Your ticket sales are going to look different this year than in the past!

Tickets will be sold online through dance ticketing website.

♦ Ticket sales begin beginning of May.

AIM families get first access unlimited amount of purchased tickets per show/per family.

After the first week, tickets go on sale to the public with no ticket limit.

Tickets will range from \$20 - \$30.





FAQ - WHY DO TICKETS COST MONEY?

AIM puts on a fully staffed, professional production so that you can sit back and relax!

Your tickets pay for our team & the performing arts centers team to put on the best show we can for you.

Complete with audio, lighting, videography and our full AIM staff caring for your children backstage and more!





FAQ - WHAT ABOUT HAIR & MAKEUP?


SPARK/Ascend $(7+) \rightarrow Low ponytail$ (except for ballet = low bun)

BOYS - Hair clean out of face. If they have long hair, they are welcome to match the girls or do something different but hair must be out of the face.

Makeup Requirements:

Dancers should wear stage makeup for photos & performances so the stage lights don't wash out their skin tone.

X No jewelry, bright nail polish/






FAQ - STAGE MAKEUP 101

Stage makeup looks intense up close but appears natural under bright lights—trust the process! 🖈

For penguin dancers (6 & under): Stick to blush (Step 2), lipstick (Step 6), and a little mascara (Step 5) if they allow it.

- Face: Apply foundation/concealer for an even skin tone & set with powder.
- 2 Blush: Use berry or pink blush from cheekbones to apples apply generously!
- 3 Eyeshadow: Dark brown in the crease Medium tone on the lid Light shimmer on the center & inner corner (For darker skin tones: Add a medium-bright purple in the crease.
- 4 Eyeliner: Small winged liner to enhance the eyes (liquid or felt tip works best).
- 5 Lashes: Apply mascara; fake lashes optional
- 6 Lips: Finish with berry pink lipstick!







FAQ - WE GOT OUR COSTUME! NOW WHAT?

- 11 It Fits Costumes are tried on in class. If it doesn't look great for stage, we won't send it home. Leotard/tutu styles should fit snug, like a swimsuit.
- 2 Hang It Up Store it safely (we recommend a grown-up's closet!).
- 3 Keep It Clean No wearing it until after the show! If something happens, DO NOT wash it—ask the front desk for help. Keep all pieces together & LABELED.
- 4 Picture Day & Recital Ready Arrive in costume, hair, and stage makeup for both.
- 5 Show Time! Come dressed and ready to shine! If your dancer has multiple costumes, label everything, and we'll handle changes backstage.





FAQ - HOW LONG IS THE SHOW? DO I HAVE TO STAY THE WHOLE TIME?

The show will run approximately 1.5 - 2 hours.

Including a 20 minute intermission

Yes, your dancer will remain backstage the entire time. They will appear on stage during their classes dances AND for finale bows at the end!

Tiny 2s are the only exception.





FAQ - WILL THERE BE PHOTOS OF

MY DANCER?

Yes! Group & individual photos will be taken for all youth dancers

We will not do live action photos during the show.

Flash photography & video recording are not allowed during performances.


- ALL NEW media packages coming this year!
- Red Carpet Photo Week
- May 27-31: All students (During regularly scheduled class, Monday dancers will be combined on Saturday.)
- *Bring all costumes, shoes and accessories for that class. Come hair and Makeup ready!
- Dancers arrive in costume during regular class time, at least one parent attends for information meeting.





FAQ - CAN I PICK UP AFTER THEY DANCE?

- ✓ No. All dancers are checked in at the beginning of the show and remain backstage until the final bow.
- ✓ AIM staff & select parent volunteers care for dancers throughout the show.
- ✓ Water, snacks & entertainment are provided backstage.
- ✓ Dancers are not released during intermission.
- ♦ Tiny 2s Exception: Parents of 2-year-olds must pick up their dancer after they perform.
