GLACIER NATIONAL PARK
Glacier National Park (GNP) is an American National Park of over a million acres in northwestern Montana that borders Watkinson Lakes National Park in Canada. The two parks are known as Waterton-Glacier International Peace Park and were designated as the world's first International Peace Park in 1932. The Blackfeet Indian Reservation establishes most of its eastern boundary. Other classifications include World Heritage Site and International Dark Sky Park, the first transboundary dark sky park in the world. This park includes two sub-ranges of the Rocky Mountains which began to form over 170 million years ago. Of the estimated 150 glaciers from the Little Ice Age which ended in the mid 1800's, only 25 remained in 2010. Most of GNP's original native plant and animal species have survived and thrived. In 1891, the Great Northern Railway crossed the Continental Divide at over 5000 feet in the southern end of the park bringing this region worldwide fame. The Glacier National Park was established by President William Howard Taft in 1910.

NATIVE AMERICAN ROOTS
10,000 years ago, Native American tribal peoples began to arrive to the Glacier area. Some of these early inhabitants have ancestral ties to current tribes alive today. The Flathead (Salish), Kootenai, Shoshone, Cheyenne and the Blackfeet all practiced their native religions in this region for thousands of years. According to the Blackfeet, the mountains of this area were considered to be the sacred backbone of the world. Two areas, in particular, Chief Mountain and Two Medicine, were and still are considered by many tribes as destinations for vision quests.
