## Mt. Hood National Forest

The Mount Hood National Forest is over 1,000,000 acres of pristine high alpine thickly forested mountainous terrain located between the Columbia River and the Santiam River in the northern Willamette Valley of Oregon. It contains and is named for Oregon's highest mountain (11,245'), Mount Hood.

This famously pointed mountain has 4,000,000 visitors each year. Outdoor enthusiasts come to ski, fish, boat, raft, hunt, hike, ride horses, climb rocks and mountains and collect berries and mushrooms. Wildlife observers enjoy the spectacular views that all life in the Cascade Range has to offer. Also, for the history buffs, there is also a narrowing portion of the old Mt Hood Road (aka Sam Barlow's Road) here. This perilous road was funded in 1845 to develop a passable route through the Cascades. It brought many settlers who were willing to drive their families and household stuffs in covered wagons, along with their livestock, all of the way across the country. They came from the east to settle and start life over in the Willamette Valley.

Of the approximate 170 recreational sites in Mount Hood National Forest, Timberline Lodge is its crowning achievement. This world famous ski resort is central to all mountain snow activity. During the Great Depression in 1934-1938, many nearby workers including artisans were employed. They used local raw and recycled materials to form this iconic lodge and its many works of art. Today, this historic lodge is one of the world's rare art areas that offers skiing and snowboarding all year round.

Prior to the European settlers arriving here, the Puyallup, Yakima, Klickitat and the Cowlitz tribes of native people living in this region for thousands of years called this mountain W'y-wast. Their tribal ancestors handed down fascinating legends of this region. The Puyallup tell of large volcanic eruptions between Klickitat (Mt. Adams) and W'y-wast (Mt. Hood) that burned entire villages and neighboring forests. Cooswiltikla which means "Lady of Fire" (Mt. St Helens) was the ancestor place where they gradually went to get fire. During the eruptions, Cooswiltikla (Mt. St Helens) remained wild and peaceful wrapped in snow as the two brother volcanoes, Klickitat and W'y-wast, fought over her.

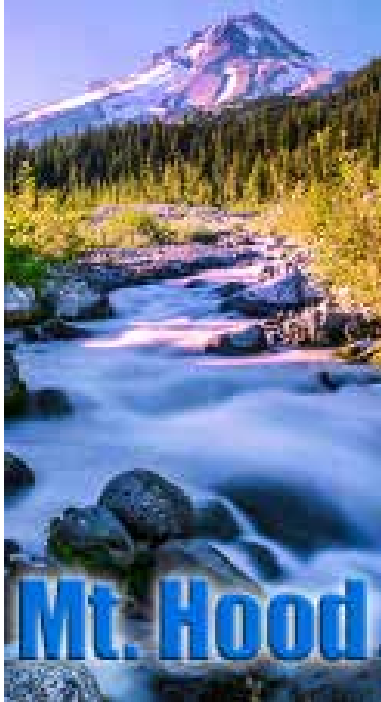

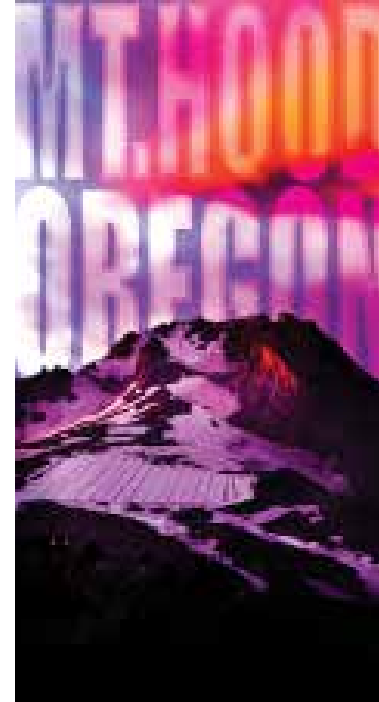

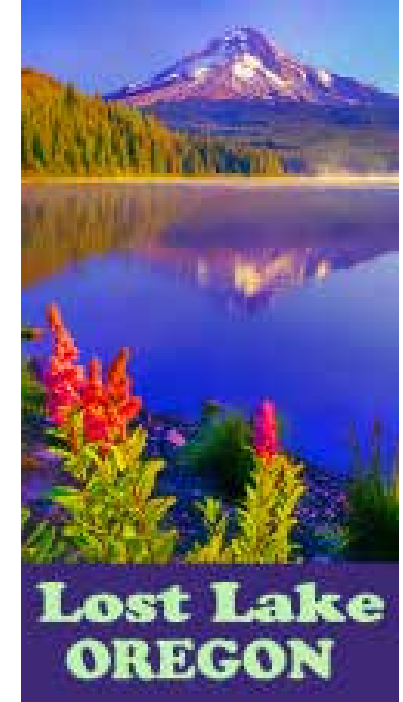
