You will be required to show you can read and interpret electrical drawings at interview stage. Experience working with Siemens and Allen Bradley equipment is desirable, ability to freehand loom in complex control panels is a huge plus. Knowledge of various standards such as IEC60204 and ul508a is beneficial.
