- A Grace to Give, continued: Everything belongs to the Lord Psalms 24:1-2
- We are tested with money, wealth and materials just like Adam/Chavah Tree of knowledge of good and evil. We need to be taught, its not natural.
- We are caregivers and Stewards of what God gives us: Rom 14:12 & Matt 25
- Money is both Physical & Spiritual: Matt 6:21 "where your treasure is so is your heart"
- If you want to be a Spiritual person, you need to gain dominance over money!
- Money had a terrible grip on the rich young man, so much so the only way was to sell
- God tests them because He loves them: Mark 10
- Peter got the gist of what Yeshua said in: Mark 10:28-31 We will receive 100x houses, brothers, sisters, mothers, children and property in this age for the sake of the Gospel
- Having a grace to give, following Messiah's lead on becoming poor on our behalf! 2Cor
 8:9, even unto death Phlp 2:5-11, even as a criminal.
- Never fear when God is challenging us to be generous. God will bless you so much you will lose your fear! He will supply our needs in ways we can't imagine! Trust in Him

Part 7 - Highlights

- 2 Corinthians 8:7 Excell in this Grace of giving
- We can do so sparingly or abundantly, that depends on us! That's dictates our harvest
- We can't "meddle" with the seed once its planted, expect favoritism. Mark 4:27-29
- Seed bears after its own kind: Gen 1:12, Isa 55:9-13. Example 2 Kings 4
- 2 Corinthians 9:6-15 God loves a cheerful giver!
- "A cheerful giver" in Greek: Strongs 2431 λαρός hilaros hil-ar-os' From the same as G2436; propitious or merry ("hilarious"), that is, prompt or willing: cheerful.
- No sense of loss or sadness with the separation of his money from himself! "Consider it joy" Great sense of expectation of opportunity to invest, much greater than any pain from the loss! Therefore, he can give "hilariously" ©
- God supplies the seed, and will increase our harvest of righteousness, "enriching us" and through us, it brings thanksgiving to God!
- The cheerful giver subscribes to a lifestyle of becoming a channel for God (infinite).
- Seed will never be bigger than the harvest, God gains nothing by bringing us to ruin.
- Rich = Needs are met, seed to sow! When we partner with him, He'll have us do more

Or to let scripture summarize:

Proverbs 11:24-26 Some give freely and still get richer, while others are stingy but grow still poorer. The person who blesses others will prosper; he who satisfies others will be satisfied himself. The people will curse him who withholds grain; but if he sells it, blessings will be on his head.

Infinite Money Hack





The three storehouses:

Immediate use, pantry, refrigerator, starter for the next loaf

1. Deut 28:5 Blessed will be your basket and your kneading bowl.

Intermediate use, a stockpile, longer term

2. Deut 28:8 Adonai will command the blessing on you in your barns and in every undertaking of your hand, and He will bless you in the land Adonai your God is giving you.

Heavenly Storehouse! For use here on earth!

3. Deut 28:12 Adonai will open for you <u>His good storehouse—the</u> <u>heavens</u>—to give <u>rain for your land in its season</u> and to <u>bless all the work of your hand</u>. You will lend to many nations, but you will not borrow.

Cornerstone Texts:

Proverbs 3:9-10 Honor Adonai with your wealth and with the first of your entire harvest. Then your <u>Storehouses</u> will be filled with plenty, your vats will overflow with new wine.

Malachi 3:10 Bring the whole tenth into the <u>storehouse</u>, so that there will be food in my house, and put me to the test," says Adonai-Tzva'ot. "See if I won't open for you the floodgates <u>of heaven</u> and pour out for you a blessing far beyond your needs.

What we do on Earth...

Triggers a response from Heaven!



Life Abundantly

Joh 10:10 The thief comes only to steal, slaughter, and destroy. I have come that they might have life, and have it abundantly!

- Money does not enable us to live life to the fullest.
- Generous people are focused on the long term, things that are 1Tim 6:17-19 Direct those who are rich in this present age to be proud or to fix their hope on the uncertainty of riches, rather on God—who richly provides us with everything to enjoy irect them to do good, to be rich in good deeds, to be generous laring, storing up for themselves a good foundation for the future they might take hold of the true life.

Life Abundantly

- Not hope in wealth, but rich in good deeds!
- When you are obedient to God, you are setting something up for your finances, so that He is looking out for you. That doesn't mean we will never suffer a loss...

"If one of your flock was destroyed by a wild animal, I didn't bring the carcass to you but bore the loss myself" — Jacob Gen 31:39a

■ But God will work to take care of you and steer you into recovery.

Lavan answered Ya`akov, "The daughters are mine, the children are mine, the flocks are mine, and everything you see is mine! But what can I do today about these daughters of mine or the children they have borne?" Gen 31:43

Generosity = Treasures in Heaven

1Tim 6:18-19 Direct them to do good, to be rich in good deeds, to be generous, sharing, storing up for themselves a good foundation for the future, so they might take hold of the true life.

- It's not enough to "hope" that things will work out. We need to be rich in good deeds and be generous with the things that God has blessed us with. Remember, He owns EVERYTHING! Psalms 24:1
- Generous people are those who enable Gods vision and will to become reality.
- God rarely gives the visionary all the money that he needs, He uses Sowers to partner with the messengers in the work.
- And all share in the harvest.

Sharing in the Harvest

1Samuel 30:21-25 When David reached the 200 men—who had been too exhausted to follow David and were left at Wadi Besor—they came out to meet David and to meet the men with him, so David approached these people and greeted them. But all the wicked men and worthless fellows among those who accompanied David said, "Because they did not accompany us, we shouldn't give them any of the spoil that we've recovered, except every man may take his wife and his children and leave." "You must not do so, my brothers with what Adonai has given us," David said. "It is He who has protected us and gave into our hands the raiding band that attacked us. Who would listen to you in this matter? The share of him who went down to the battle is to be the same as that of him who remained by the baggage. They will share alike." So it has been from that day forward—he made it a statute and an ordinance for Israel to this day.

Sharing in the Harvest

- They were with us in Spirit, even though they were not there...
- This is the same way the body supports missionaries and outreach. Even though we did not go, we share in the process...
- We're at home tending to the "baggage" the "flock etc... Others are abroad working for the Kingdom. Both are doing a key function.
- If you support Missionaries...
 - ☐ You've have blessed people you have never met!
 - ☐ You've visited places you've never been to!
 - ☐ You've built churches you've never attended!
- I stayed here with the "stuff" but we share in the reward for everything the "sent" have done!


Romans 10:13-15 For "Everyone who calls upon the name of Adonai shall be saved." How then shall they call on the One in whom they have not trusted? Treasures in Heaven

- That's why its so important to store up treasures in Heaven, because we get to be apart of something that is sooooo much BIGGER than our ordinary lives!
- It's amazing what God enables us to be apart of!

Deuteronomy 28:12
Adonai will open for you
His good storehouse—
the heavens—to give rain
for your land in its season
and to bless all the work
of your hand. You will
lend to many nations, but
you will not borrow.

Matthew 6:19-20 "Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy and where thieves break in and steal. But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys and where thieves do not break in or steal.

Mark 10:29-30 "Amen, I tell you," Yeshua replied, "there is no one who has left house or brothers or sisters or mother or father or children or property, for My sake and for the sake of the Good News, who will not receive a hundred times as much now in this time, ... along with persecutions; and in the olam ha-ba, eternal life.

The purse...

Luke 9:1-6 Now when Yeshua called the twelve together, He gave them power and authority over all the demons and to heal diseases. He sent them out to proclaim the kingdom of God and to heal. And He said to them, "Take nothing for the journey—no walking stick, no travel bag, no bread, no money, nor even to have two shirts. Whatever house you enter, stay there and depart from there. And whoever does not receive you, when you leave that town, shake off the dust from your feet as a witness against them." So they went out and began traveling throughout the villages, proclaiming the Good News and healing everywhere.

- Sent to Israel first to fulfill the promises/prophecy, a Grace to do it
- Nothing could interfere with this offer of Kingdom to Israel:
 Luke 4:28-30

The Grace on Yeshu's Messianic Ministry to Israel:

Threats made or plots discussed but not acted on Matthew 12:14, Mark 11:18, Luke 13:31–33

The purse, an update

Luke 22:35-38 And He said to them, "When I sent you out without a money pouch and travel bag and sandals, you didn't lack anything, did you?" They said, "No, nothing." Then He said to them, "But now, whoever has a money pouch must carry it as well as a travel bag. And whoever does not own a sword must sell his cloak and buy one. For I tell you that this which is written must be fulfilled in Me: 'And he was counted with the lawless.' For what is written about Me is being fulfilled." But they said, "Master, look here! Two swords!" And He said to them, "It is enough."

Focus shift:

Matthew 10:5 Yeshua sent out these twelve and ordered them, "Do not go to the Gentiles, and do not enter into any Samaritan town. But go instead to the lost sheep of the house of Israel.

Luke 24:45-49 Then He opened their minds to understand the Scriptures, and He said to them, "So it is written, that the Messiah is to suffer and to rise from the dead on the third day, and that repentance for the removal of sins is to be proclaimed in His name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem. You are witnesses of these things. And behold, I am sending the promise of My Father upon you; but you are to stay in the city until you are clothed with power from on high."

- Wedding Parable: Matthew 22:1-10
- Shift to the Nations: Acts 13:46

Purse and People: Updates

- So, what changed?
- Yeshua had a special Grace on His ministry to allow Him to be a witness as the Messiah to Israel (Kingdom offer) for a set time (3 1/2 years). [John 2:13, 6:4, 11:55 to 12:1 & Daniel 9:27]
- Mirrored by the two witnesses: Revelation 11:3
- Yeshua is about to die as He stated in Luke 22,, the kingdom was rejected and the Good News sent to the Gentiles. (Thus, all Israel shall be saved ~ Paul Romans 11).
- The Grace on His ministry was about to end! Here comes persecution and tribulation! After the earthly ministry ended there was a mission update!

Examples: Yeshua & Paul Pre & Post earthly Ministry

Mat 8:26-27 He said to them, "Why are you afraid, O you of little faith?" Then He got up and rebuked the winds and the sea, and it became totally calm. The men were amazed, saying, "What kind of person is this? Even the winds and the sea obey Him!"

2Cor 11:25 Three times I was beaten with rods. Once I was stoned. Three times I suffered shipwreck. A night and a day I spent in the open sea.

■ See Acts 27:1-44

Mission Updates:

- Even though Paul was an Apostle, there was a divine authority on Yeshua for protection and provision that you don't see later.
- That's why when the Gospel went out to the Nations from Israel, money for Travel, Food, Boarding and Ministry was now needed.
- They would not experience the same hospitality that was afforded to the Messiah and His talmidim during His earthly ministry.
- That was a special calling for a specific time that called for a special Grace and Anointing.

Mission Update:

- The supernatural provision of finances and resources on Messiah's earthly ministry had to do with the uniqueness of His mission and calling.
- No modern-day ministry can pattern all of its financial operations after Messiah's early ministry.
- What we can do is look at the 14 times Yeshua's ministry was supernaturally provided for, see how it operated emphasizing Heavenly Storehouses and follow the directions He left us concerning ministry prior to His departure.
- The three primary ways God provided for His son:
 Deuteronomy 28 Immediate, Long Term & Heavenly!
