# God Created, What Could Go Wrong?

(Hint: Man's Sin)

Psa 10:2-4 In arrogance, the wicked hunt down the weak. They are caught in the schemes that they devise. (3) For the wicked boasts of his heart's cravings. He blesses the greedy, and condemns YHWH. (4) The wicked, **in the pride of his face**, has no room in his thoughts for God.

1Jn 2:15-17 Do not love the world, neither the things that are in the world. If anyone loves the world, the Father's love is not in him. (16) For all that is in the world, the **lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life**, is not the Father's, but is the world's. (17) The world is passing away with its lusts, but he who does God's will remains forever.

# What are Husbands supposed to do?

---

**Eph 5:23-27** For the husband is the head of the wife, and Messiah also is the head of the congregation, being himself the savior of the body. (24) But as the congregation is subject to Messiah, so let the wives also be to their own husbands in everything. (25) Husbands, love your wives, even as Messiah also loved the congregation, and gave himself up for it; (26) that he might sanctify it, having cleansed it by the washing of water with the word, (27) that he might present the congregation to himself gloriously, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.

# What are Husbands supposed to do?

---

**Eph 5:28-33** Even so husbands also ought to love their own wives as their own bodies. He who loves his own wife loves himself. (29) For no man ever hated his own flesh; but nourishes and cherishes it, even as Messiah also does the congregation; (30) because we are members of his body. (31) "For this cause a man will leave his father and mother, and will be joined to his wife. The two will become one flesh." (32) This mystery is great, but I speak concerning Messiah and of the congregation. (33) Nevertheless each of you must also love his own wife even as himself; and let the wife see that she respects her husband.



# What are Husbands supposed to do?

---

**Col 3:19** Husbands, love your wives, and do not be bitter against them.

**1Pe 3:7** You husbands, in like manner, live with your wives according to knowledge, giving honor to the woman, as to the weaker vessel, as being also joint heirs of the grace of life; that your prayers may not be hindered.

**1Ti 3:1-5** This is a faithful saying: if a man seeks the office of an overseer, he desires a good work. (2) The overseer therefore must be without reproach, the husband of one wife, temperate, sensible, modest, hospitable, good at teaching; (3) not a drunkard, not violent, but gentle, not quarrelsome, not a lover of money; (4) one who rules his own house well, having children in subjection with all reverence; (5) (but if a man does not know how to rule his own house, how will he take care of the congregation of God?)

**Tit 1:6** if anyone is blameless, the husband of one wife, having children who believe, who are not accused of loose or unruly behavior.

# Review of Husbands Actions

- A man will leave his father and mother and will be joined to his wife. The two will become one flesh.
- The Husband of one wife
- The Husband is the ( kef-al-ay') Overseer or Head of the Wife like Messiah is Head of the Assembly. (Can mean Cornerstone of the family)
- Love your wife as Messiah loves the assembly and gave himself up for it.
- Not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish
- He who loves his own wife loves himself
- Do not be bitter against your wife
- Give honor to the woman, as to the weaker vessel, as being also joint heirs of the grace of life; that your prayers may not be hindered
- One who rules his own house well, having children in subjection with all reverence
- Having children who believe, who are not accused of loose or unruly behavior

# What are Wives supposed to do?

---

**Gen 2:18** The LORD God said, "It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him a **helper suitable** for him." Hebrew (Helper or counterpart before him)

**Gen 2:21-25** The LORD God caused a deep sleep to fall on the man, and he slept; and he took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh in its place. **(22)** He made the rib, which the LORD God had taken from the man, into a woman, and brought her to the man. **(23)** The man said, "This is now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh. # What are Wives supposed to do?

---

**Eph 5:22** Wives, be subject to your own husbands, as to the Lord.

**Eph 5:24** But as the congregation is subject to Messiah, so let the wives also be to their own husbands in everything.

**1Ti 3:11** Their wives in the same way must be reverent, not slanderers, temperate, faithful in all things.

**1Pe 3:1** In like manner, wives, be in subjection to your own husbands; so that, even if any do not obey the Word, they may be won by the behavior of their wives without a word;

**1Pe 3:7** You husbands, in like manner, live with your wives according to knowledge, giving honor to the woman, as to the weaker vessel, as being also joint heirs of the grace of life; that your prayers may not be hindered.



# What are Wives supposed to do?

---

**Mat 5:32** but I tell you that everyone who puts away his wife, except for the cause of sexual immorality, makes her an adulteress; and whoever marries her when she is put away commits adultery.

**Luk 17:32** Remember Lot's wife!

**Act 5:9** But Peter asked her, "How is it that you have agreed together to tempt the Spirit of the Lord? Behold, the feet of those who have buried your husband are at the door, and they will carry you out."

**1Co 7:2-4** But, because of sexual immoralities, let each man have his own wife, and let each woman have her own husband. (3) Let the husband fulfill his marital duty to his wife, and likewise also the wife to her husband. (4) The wife does not have authority over her own body, but the husband. Likewise also the husband does not have authority over his own body, but the wife.

# Review of Wives Actions

- The wife will be a counterpart helper
- “She will be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man.”
- Will join with her husband and they will be one flesh
- Subject to husband, not the overseer
- Must be reverent, not slanderers, temperate, faithful in all things.
- Win over unbelieving husbands through their behavior
- Receives honor from their husband as the weaker vessel
- Must keep away from sexual sin including adultery
- Must abide by husband’s decisions
- Should not agree with the husband when he wants to commit sin
- Marital duty husband to wife and wife to husband
- Husband has right over wife’s body and wife has right over husband’s body

## Scripture Wisdom for Reflection in a Marriage

**Pro 12:18** There is one who speaks rashly like the piercing of a sword, but the tongue of the wise heals.

**Pro 15:1-4** A gentle answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger. The tongue of the wise commends knowledge, but the mouth of fools gush out folly. YHWH's eyes are everywhere, keeping watch on the evil and the good. A gentle tongue is a tree of life, but deceit in it crushes the spirit.

**Pro 16:24** Pleasant words are a honeycomb, sweet to the soul, and health to the bones.

**Jas 1:22** But be doers of the word, and not only hearers, deluding your own selves.

**Jas 3:4-10** Behold, the ships also, though they are so big and are driven by fierce winds, are yet guided by a very small rudder, wherever the pilot desires. (5) So the tongue is also a little member, and boasts great things. See how a small fire can spread to a large forest! (6) And the tongue is a fire. # When does God See Life?

**Gen 25:23** YHWH said to her, Two nations are in your womb. Two peoples will be separated from your body. The one people will be stronger than the other people. The elder will serve the younger.

# Half-Way Review of Children

- We are told in Scripture to procreate!
- Since the fall of Adam, women have pain in childbirth.
- YHWH is a Father to all his children; we need to learn from Him!
- He created us and loves us from the womb!
- Procreation has brought forth Yeshua, the Messiah, it is important!
- Children need to learn to rely on Him!
- Even if our Father or Mother forgets us or treats us badly, “Yes, these may forget, yet I will not forget you!”

- Children are important, from conception!

# What does the World Teach?

**From Harvard Medical School:** "According to a policy statement (Effective Discipline to Raise Healthy Children) recently released by the American Academy of Pediatrics, "aversive" discipline techniques like yelling and spanking are a really bad idea. Not only do studies show that they don't work that well, they can have long-term negative effects."

**From the American Academy of Pediatrics:** Spanking and harsh words are harmful and don't work. Here's why: "Effective Discipline to Raise Healthy Children," highlights why it's important to focus on teaching good behavior rather than punishing bad behavior. Research shows that spanking, slapping and other forms of physical punishment don't work well to correct a child's behavior. The same holds true for yelling at or shaming a child. Beyond being ineffective, harsh physical and verbal punishments can also damage a child's long-term physical and mental health.

**Children's Hospital of Philadelphia:** "By modeling aggressive behavior, these kinds of discipline can lead children to act in more aggressive ways with their peers, and as they grow up, with intimate partners and their own children.

Research has shown a relationship between these kinds of discipline and higher rates of depression and other mental health problems later in life.

The negative outcomes for children who are spanked are similar to those for children who experience physical abuse."

# What does His Word Teach?

**Exo 14:16** Lift up your rod, and stretch out your hand over the sea, and divide it: and the children of Israel shall go into the midst of the sea on dry ground.

**Psa 23:4** Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me. Your rod and your staff, they comfort me.

**Psa 89:31-33** if they break my statutes, and do not keep my commandments; then I will punish their sin with the rod, and their iniquity with stripes. **(33)** But I will not completely take my loving kindness from him, nor allow my faithfulness to fail.

**Pro 13:24** One who spares the rod hates his son, but one who loves him is careful to discipline him.

**Pro 22:15** Folly is bound up in the heart of a child: the rod of discipline drives it far from him.

**Pro 23:13-14** Do not withhold correction from a child. If you punish him with the rod, he will not die. **(14)** Punish him with the rod and save his soul from Sheol.

**Pro 29:15** The rod of correction gives wisdom, but a child left to himself causes shame to his mother.



# What does His Word Teach?

Eze 20:37-44 "I will cause you to pass under the rod, and I will bring you into the bond of the covenant; (38) and I will purge out from among you the rebels, and those who disobey against me; I will bring them forth out of the land where they live, but they shall not enter into the land of Israel: and you shall know that I am YHWH." (39) "'As for you, house of Israel, thus says the Lord YHWH: "Go, serve everyone his idols, and hereafter also, if you will not listen to me; but my holy name you shall no more profane with your gifts, and with your idols. (40) For in my holy mountain, in the mountain of the height of Israel," says the Lord YHWH, "there shall all the house of Israel, all of them, serve me in the land: there will I accept them, and there will I require your offerings, and the first fruits of your offerings, with all your holy things. (41) As a pleasant aroma will I accept you, when I bring you out from the peoples, and gather you out of the countries in which you have been scattered; and I will be sanctified in you in the sight of the nations. (42) You shall know that I am YHWH, when I shall bring you into the land of Israel, into the country which I swore to give to your fathers. (43) There you shall remember your ways, and all your doings, in which you have polluted yourselves; and you shall loathe yourselves in your own sight for all your evils that you have committed. (44) You shall know that I am YHWH, when I have dealt with you for my name's sake, not according to your evil ways, nor according to your corrupt doings, you house of Israel," says the Lord YHWH.'"

# What does His Word Teach?

**Mic 6:9** YHWH's voice calls to the city, and wisdom sees your name: "Listen to the rod, and he who appointed it.

**Rev 19:15** Out of his mouth proceeds a sharp sword, that with it he should strike the nations. He will rule them with an iron rod. He treads the winepress of the fierceness of the wrath of God, the Almighty.

**Pro 14:3** The fool's talk brings a rod to his back, but the lips of the wise protect them.

**Pro 26:3** A whip is for the horse, a bridle for the donkey, and a rod for the back of fools!

**1Co 4:20-21** For the Kingdom of God is not in word, but in power. **(21)** What do you want? Shall I come to you with a rod, or in love and a spirit of gentleness?

**Mat 19:13-15** Then little children were brought to him, that he should lay his hands on them and pray; and the disciples rebuked them. **(14)** But Jesus said, "Allow the little children, and do not forbid them to come to me; for the Kingdom of Heaven belongs to ones like these." **(15)** He placed his hands on them, and departed from there.



# Learnings from His Word Regarding Discipline

- He Has appointed the Rod(Micah) His Word teaches the Rod is for discipline.
- Are your hands a rod? Is your yelling a rod? Is Shaming a rod? No!
- Hands are for loving! (Yeshua's example in Matt)
- YHWH's example is using the rod, for the result of repentance & restoration.
- There are many examples in Scripture about YHWH's rod coming on His people to work out sin and defilement through repentance and restoration
- Discipline with the rod, ask the child to repent, If not discipline again, once the child had repented, restore him, forgive and hug them.
- This is not about shaming, but showing them that sin gets the rod, and hands love!
- From me: When spanking use a rod that stings but does not wound, remember this is about repentance/restoring not taking our frustration out!
