## Guidance, being led by the spirit

- Pro 20:27 The <a href="human spirit">human spirit</a> (Neshamat נישמת) is a <a href="lamp">lamp</a> (Nur ינר) of Adonai; it searches one's inmost being. ~ CJB
- Pro 20:27 The <u>lifebreath of man (Neshamat נשׁמת)</u> is the lamp (Nur נרר) of the LORD; Revealing all his inmost parts. ~ JPS
- Pro 20:27 The <u>spirit of man (Neshamat נשׁמת)</u> is the <u>lamp</u> (Nur נרֹר) of Adonai, searching all his inmost being. ~ TLV
- Pro 20:27 The <u>spirit of a man (Neshamat נשׁמת)</u> is the <u>lamp (Nur נרֹר)</u> of the LORD, Searching all the inner depths of his heart. ~ KJV
- Pro 20:27 The <u>spirit of man (Neshamat נשׁמת)</u> is the <u>candle (Nur נרֹר)</u> of Yahweh, searching all the inward parts of the belly. ~ WOY

### "HUMAN SPIRIT" (NESHAMA)

## Guidance, being led by the spirit

- Gen 2:7 Then Adonai, God, formed a person [Hebrew: adam] from the dust of the ground [Hebrew: adamah] and breathed into his nostrils the breath (Neshamat נשׁמת) of life, so that he became a living being.
- Job 32:8 But it is the spirit (Ruach) in a person, the <u>breath</u> (Neshamat נשמת) from Shaddai, that gives him understanding —
- 1Cor 2:11 For who knows the inner workings of a person except the person's own <u>spirit</u> (pneuma) inside him? So too no one knows the inner workings of God except God's <u>Spirit</u> (pneuma).
- God knows us best! Better than we do!

## How it begins:

- The spirit within us (Neshamah) is what Yahweh uses to search us and to communicate with us through His Spirit (The Holy Spirit) Gen 2:7 & Psa 150:5
- Gods spirit is sevenfold! Rev 1:4, 3:1, 4:5 & 5:6 The seven are specified in Isaiah 11
- All spiritual gifts and all truth emanate from the Sevenfold Holy Spirit
- Gods spirit is truth and works in tandem with the written word to guide us and lead us in His paths of Righteousness (step by step)! Psalm 23:3
- The spirit going to all people was a radical idea! Joel 3 (OT: Kings, Leaders, Prophets...)
- All people now have access to the Holy Spirit through Yeshua's glorification
- Confession that Yeshua is Lord and was raised from the dead is confirmed by our "inward witness" (spirit). Opening the door to receive the indwelling Holy Spirit! Read Romans 10:8-12

#### What it does:

- Through Messiah we are a NEW CREATION! 2 Corinthians 5:19
- Our Hearts without the Holy Spirit are Deceitful Jerimiah 17:9-10
- Our Hearts with the Holy Spirit are well intentioned, writing Gods Laws and desires within us! Deut 30:6, Ezek 36:25-27 & Jer 31:31-33
- We are at War with our flesh! Rom 6:7-14, Rom 7:14-25 & Gal 5:16-25
- Most of the confirmation signs God gives us today are inward through the Spirit
  - These are confirmations from the Holy Spirit to our Neshama (Spirit)!
  - o God can still do outward confirmation signs, but we should not seek them. Seek and wait for the inner sign!
- The outward signs will follow us when we are inhabited with the Holy Spirit Mark 16:17-18
- Yeshua won the right to lead the sheep by entering through the front gate, Satan did not enter the front gate and is here to steal kill & destroy. John 10 & Php 2:5-11
- We can distinguish the difference between the voice of the Lamb and the voice of the enemy. John 10, Rev 14:1-4, Rev, 2:7, Rev 2:29, Rev 3:6, Rev 3:13, Rev 3:22 & Rev 13:9

### The inward "Amen":

Rom 8:15-17 For you did not receive a spirit of slavery to bring you back again into fear; on the contrary, you received the Spirit, who makes us sons and by whose power we cry out, "Abba!" (that is, "Dear Father!"). The Spirit himself bears witness with our own spirits that we are children of God; and if we are children, then we are also heirs, heirs of God and joint-heirs with the Messiah — provided we are suffering with him in order also to be glorified with him.

The inward witness confirms "amen" agreement with <u>statements</u>, <u>intentions</u> or <u>ideas</u>. It can be a positive confirmation, or it can witness against the statement, intention, idea or situation.

### How it works:

- The "inward amen" in confirmation positive/negative Yes/No
- Responds to Statements, Intentions and Idea's Act 16:6-10 & Rom 8:15-17
- It is a "deep sense" from Gods Spirit to our Spirit. It's not a feeling, idea, or emotion from our head.

Psa 16:7 I bless Adonai, my counselor; at night my inmost being instructs me.

- Foreshadowed by the Urim and Tumin Num 27:21
  - Lights & Perfections. The Good and perfect will of God in our situations! Eph 5:13, 2Sam 22:33, Pro 4:18
  - Worn over the "heart" foreshadowing the Spirit writing the Torah on our heart Exo 28:30-31
- The Holy Spirit is aware and see's the Spiritual Realm Eph 2:2 & Eph 6:12
  - Alerts us to the presence of unclean Spirits John 11, Act 16:16-18, Act 18:5 & Act 17:16-17
- We are strengthened by seeking the Spirit: 1Sam 23:16 & 1Sam 30:6
- Gives us the passion to speak about the Word fervently! Act 18:24-25 (The right amount of "emotion")
- Yeshua was obedient to the Spirit and adjusted His plans accordingly John 4:3-4 & Mat 4:1

Rom 8:14 "For all who are led by the Ruach Elohim, these are sons of God".

## The Spiritual Person

• Read 1 Cor 2:6-15

1Cor 2:14-15 Now the natural man does not receive the things from the Spirit of God — to him they are nonsense! Moreover, he is unable to grasp them, because they are evaluated through the Spirit. But the person who has the Spirit can evaluate everything, while no one is in a position to evaluate him.

• What does it mean to be "Spiritual"? Emotional, Religious, led by feelings? Maybe part crazy? No....

#### PHYSICAL & SPIRITUAL SENSES

There are **5-Physical senses** and there are **5-Spiritual senses**:

The Ruach HaKodesh enables activation of all senses:

- 1. Hearing: Inward Witness, Perception, Prophecy, Words, Faith (Rev 2:7, 11, 17 & 29)
- 2. Seeing: Salvation, Visions, Dreams & Perception Psa 34:8 & 2 Cor 4:4
- 3. Tasting: Discernment Psa 34:8, 2 Pet 2:22 & Heb 6:4-5
- 4. Touching: Visions, Faith Rev 1:10, Mat 9:21, Mark 8:22 & Luke 24:39
- 5. Smelling: Giving Praise, Worship & Prayer Psa 141:2, Rev 5:8 & 8:3-5
- 1Cor 12:16-17 And if the ear says, "I'm not an eye, so I'm not part of the body," that doesn't make it stop being part of the body. If the whole body were an eye, how could it hear? If it were all hearing, how could it smell?

Dull spiritual senses: Isa 6:10, Isa 44:18, Jer 5:21 & Mat 13:13-14

## The Spiritual Person:

- The "Natural Man" vs the "Spiritual Man" 1Cor 2:14-15
- The Spiritual Man is lead by knowledge not revealed to him through one of the 5 physical senses
  - o Mat 16:13-17 & John 4:23-24
- We have 5 physical senses; we have 5 Spiritual senses as well: 2Ki 6:15-18 & Psa 34:8
  - o "Those who have ears let them hear what the Spirit is saying": Rev, 2:7, 2:29, 3:6, 3:13, 3:22 & 13:9
- Spiritual realities are of a higher order and authority than physical realities. You have to learn to hear, receive and obey the spiritual reality even when the physical reality doesn't look like it! 2Cor 4:18 & 2Cor 5:5-7
- God's thoughts and ways are higher and superior vs ours! When we make our soul + flesh yield to Gods spirit we bare His fruit Isa 55:8-10 & Rom 12:1-2
- God exists in three: Father, Son & Ruach HaKodesh Mat 28:19.
  - So do we, as we are made in His image (Gen 1:26):
  - 1Thes 5:23 May the God of shalom make you completely holy may your entire <u>spirit</u>, <u>soul</u> and <u>body</u> be kept blameless for the coming of our Lord Yeshua the Messiah.
- The Spiritual person is steadfast through all things: Psalm 112:7-8. Act 12:6-7 → John 21:15-19
- He uses the Natural man: Nebuchadnezzar & Pharoah. He uses the Spiritual man: Moses & David

## The specifics:

- Find your planting! (Your purpose). Psa 92:12-15, Rev 3:12, Lev 23:3, Heb 10:25 & 1Pet 4:12-15
  - In community, through the power of the Spirit 1+1=2 rather 1+1=10! Rev 2:29, 1Cor 12:18 & 1Pet 2:5
  - Wells vs Rivers [Personal Salvation (John 4) vs Congregational Power of the Ruach (John 11)]
  - o Go to a place you are "called to" vs a place you "like"
- The FOUR different ways the Ruach communicates INWARDLY (not outward):
  - 1. Inward Witness (Inward confirmation) Most Common. (Urim Thummim). God always answers believers in Good standing
  - 2. Inward Perception (Seeing/Understanding/Perceiving)
  - 3. Inward Visions Least Common
  - 4. Inward <u>Dreams</u> 2<sup>nd</sup> most common
- Perception: (Seeing) Highest form of leading, greatest insight. Like our imagination, hard to distinguish!
  - o Acts 14:8-10, 27:9-11 & John 1:45-51
- <u>Visions</u>: Open (Rev 1:10) vs closed visions (Gen 15:1-4). Can be minimized by sin 1Sam 3:1. Always futuristic
  - o Gen 15:1-21, 46:2-4, 2Sam 7:4-17, Isa 1:1-31, Ezek 12:27-28, Dan 2:19, Act 9:10-12, & 10:10-19. Confused with reality! Act 12:9
- <u>Dreams</u>: Confirm Gods plans, Symbolism used. Interpretation requires immediate action! Can be Food inspired
  - o Gen 20:3-6, 31:10-11, 37:5-11, 40:16-19, 41:1-8, Dan 2:3-16, Matt 1:20, 2:12, 2:19 & 2:22
- Joel 2 & 3: Old men dream (now urgent), young men see visions (distant future). 5-Physical/Spiritual senses!

#### WE HEAR GOD THROUGH THE SPIRIT!

- We receive these through spiritual, not physical senses.
  1Cor 2:9-10 But, as the Tanakh says, "No eye has seen, no ear has heard and no one's heart has imagined all the things that God has prepared for those who love him." It is to us, however, that God has revealed these things. How? Through the Spirit. For the Spirit probes all things, even the profoundest depths of God.
- Manner of communication, speaking to us via the Holy Spirit: John 14:16 and I will ask the Father, and he will give you another comforting Counselor like me, the Spirit of Truth, to be with you forever.

John 16:13-15 However, when the Spirit of Truth comes, he will guide you into all the truth; for he will not speak on his own initiative but will say only what he hears. He will also announce to you the events of the future. He will glorify me, because he will receive from what is mine and announce it to you. Everything the Father has is mine; this is why I said that he receives from what is mine and will announce it to you.

# "Standing in" "the good fight of faith"

1Tim 1:17 So to the King — eternal, imperishable and invisible, the only God there is — let there be honor and glory for ever and ever! Amen. This charge, son Timothy, I put to you, in keeping with the prophecies already made about you, so that by these prophecies you may fight the good fight, armed with trust and a good conscience. By rejecting conscience, some have made shipwreck of their trust; among them are Hymenaeus and Alexander. I have turned them over to the Adversary, so that they will learn not to insult God.

1Tim 6:12 Fight the good fight of the faith, take hold of the eternal life to which you were called when you testified so well to your faith before many witnesses.

# "Standing in" "the good fight of faith"

- We receive the things of God through the Spirit of God: 1 Corinthians 2:9-10, John 14:16, John 16:13-15
- God saved Israel from Egypt, and rescued them from bondage. A type and shadow of death! So that he could bring them into a blessing of the Land. A covenantal gift.
  - o These things happened to them as "prefigurative historical events" as an example and warning to us! 1Corinthians 10:1-13
- God is not in the business of just dumping gifts on our laps but expects us to fight the Good fight of Faith 1Tim 6:12. We can't "Make it happen" however, we cooperate and walk in obedience to His promises.
- God is mighty, He does the fighting. We do the "Standing firm" Eph 6:10-17. We lay hands, He heals!
  - O Satan does not want us to inherit what the Messiah already won and bought for us! He interferes at all costs!
  - o This is why God does not publicly communicate but works through the Spirit. Satan steals, kills & Destroys Jn 10
- We are at war with real spiritual forces for our salvation, peace, calling, home and heart.
  - o God does not intend the wicked to inherit riches and ownership. Our inheritance is worth fighting for!
- God gave/gifted the land to Israel (Num 13:1), but expected them to walk in His promise and "evict" the squatters
- That generation failed! Only Joshua + Caleb made it because they had the Spirit: Num 14:24, 27:18 & Duet 34:9
- The fight develops our character and enables us to be in the blessing 1Peter 1:6-7 & Romans 5:3-5
- God's strength is perfected in our weakness 2Cor 12:9. And He turns our weaknesses into strengths! Heb 11:32-35

## The Ruach was given to taste the Kingdom!

Heb 6:4-5 For when people have once <u>been enlightened</u>, tasted the <u>heavenly gift</u>, <u>become sharers in the Ruach HaKodesh</u>, and <u>tasted</u> the goodness of God's Word and the <u>powers of the</u> olam haba

- (Olam haba The world/age to come)
- (Olam hazeh This world/age)
- Powers from the Age to come through the Holy Spirit!
  - o Gods Torah inside our hearts Heb 8:10
  - Healing, no more death Rev 21:4
  - Unrestrained Praise and Worship Rev 4:8 & Rev 21:3
  - Unrestrained unity! Rev 4 & 5

## Past, present & future work together

- The past paves the way for the future: 1Corinthians 10:11 & Ecclesiastes 1:9-11
  - The opposite of how society always views history through the lens of "presentism"
- Gods leads us in steps and builds us up to His future plans: Exo 23:29-30 & 1Sam17 Lion then Bear then Giant!
  - o God leads gradually, past steps to future steps Luke 16:10
  - When we look for "steps" it narrows it down
  - o He doesn't violate His ways, he did it this way, He will continue to do it in that manner
  - Leaps are presumptuous Satan tempted Yeshua to take "a leap of faith" Matthew 4







- Its about learning the ways of God Not "claiming a promise". Exo 33:13, Deut 10:12 & Psa 25:4
  - His principles are examples for us!
  - You can learn a lot about how He is going to lead you through what has been doing with you
  - o Complete your steps and assignments, there is never a waster step!
- Wisdom from God is delivered via the Ruach! It is hidden from Wordily 1. People 2. Leaders 3. Demons 1Cor 2:6-10
- "Double Release" Yeshua didn't move into His heavenly ministry, until He released His disciples into His ministry
  - Ministry deeply matured the disciples. Peter pre-crucifixion vs post ascension is night & day! Acts 4:13 "Unlearned men" "Nobodies"
  - We must serve on His terms Pride & pre-determination get in the way This is how heavenly wisdom/spiritual growth happen Luke 16:10
- We are physical participants in a Spiritual war: Ephesians 6:10
- Satan is opposed to Gods plans. Example: Canaan, Yeshua's Birth, His return etc... "Grow powerful in Union with the Lord"
  - O Even in our "failures" Gods plan is being moved forward. Don't concern yourself with loosing a battle, its Gods master plan to win the war!

### Spiritual Warfare

Eph 6:10-13 Finally, grow powerful in union with the Lord, in union with his mighty strength! Use all the armor and weaponry that God provides, so that you will be able to stand against the deceptive tactics of the Adversary. For we are not struggling against human beings, but against the rulers, authorities and cosmic powers governing this darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realm. So take up every piece of war equipment God provides; so that when the evil day comes, you will be able to resist; and when the battle is won, you will still be standing.

- We are at war! We are opposed by spiritual enemies who have the capacity to deal tremendous influence...
- It's hard enough to overcome our flesh and other people!
- People yield to these powers and don't realize they are being used!
- We've become to intellectual, ignorant of the battle around us. Walk the Word!

## Open Doors & Freedom!

• The Superior Spiritual world: Heb 11:3, Gen 1:1-3 & Psalms 33:6-9

Mark 4:41 But they were terrified and asked each other, "Who can this be, that even the wind and the waves obey him?"

- Discern the works of God vs Human emotional response! It grieves the Spirit to equate a human response to Gods presence to a miracle as much as is grieves Him in denying the Miraculous. There is no pressure we lay hands; He does the healing!
- Acts 1:3 "many convincing proofs" Yeshua's enemies were left with only one option: attributing the miracle to Satan Mat 12:22-28
- Open Doors: Acts 14:27, 1 Cor 16:8-9, 2 Cor 2:12 & Acts 16:6-10
  - o God opens doors to His path! Search for open doors, not miracles. Open doors lead to miracles.
  - You cannot force a door open, and just because a door is open doesn't mean God opened it (discernment always applies).
  - o God opens doors to faithful people! David was "in step" with the Lord and God promoted David.
- Door authority "The keys" belong to the Messiah, we are to walk in them! Isa 22:22, Luke 11:52 & Rev 3:7-8
- Sin separates us from Gods Holy Spirit! Psa 51:11, Rev 2:5 & 1Sam 27:4-7
- Sin leads to bondage! Prov 5:22-23, Lam 1:14 & Luke 13:16
- Messiah is a "chain breaker": Isa 58:6-10, Isa 61:1 & Isa 55:5-7
- Repentance free's us from bondage: Prov 28:13, (double release Mat 6:14-15) & Acts 3:19-20
- Feed your Spirit, not your flesh! Galatians 5:16-17 & 1Samuel 30:6

## Feed your spirit, strengthen your light!

Focus on the "do's" and sin dissipates! We cannot "will our way out of sin"

Gal 5:16-17 What I am saying is this: run your lives by the Spirit. Then you will not do what your old nature wants. For the old nature wants what is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit wants what is contrary to the old nature. These oppose each other, so that you find yourselves unable to carry out your good intentions.

- Spend time in Spirit (Prayer) & Truth (The Word of God).
- Remember the ways of God and how He works. Stand firm in His calling.

1Sa 30:6 David was in serious trouble: the people were talking about stoning him to death, because all the people were in such deep grief, each man over his sons and daughters. But David strengthened himself in Adonai his God.

Fruit of the Spirit: Gal 5:22-23 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, humility, self control. Nothing in the Torah stands against such things.

### GUIDANCE, BEING LED BY THE SPIRIT

■ Gods spiritual word to us <u>ALWAYS</u> aligns with His written word, the two are <u>NEVER</u> in conflict. The spiritual word is <u>situational or specific</u> in ways the written word cannot be. It's the written word made alive for each situation's circumstances. It leads us in steps!

#### MUSIC INDUCES THE SPIRIT:

1Sam 10:5-6 After that, you will come to Giv`ah of God, where the P'lishtim are garrisoned. On arrival at the city there, you will meet a group of prophets coming down from the high place, preceded by lutes, tambourines, flutes and lyres; and they will be prophesying. Then the Spirit of Adonai will fall on you; you will prophesy with them and be turned into another man!

1Sam 10:10-12 When they arrived at the hill, and there in front of him was a group of prophets, the Spirit of God fell on him and he prophesied along with them. When those who knew him from before saw him there, prophesying with the prophets, they asked each other, "What's happened to Kish's son? Is Sha'ul a prophet, too?" Someone in the crowd answered, "Must prophets' fathers be special?" So it became an expression — "Is Sha'ul a prophet, too?"

David's anointed music drove out the evil spirit that was harassing Saul.
 1 Sam 16:14-23

### Music Induces the Spirit:

2Ki 3:14-18 Elisha said, "As Adonai-Tzva'ot lives, before whom I stand, if I didn't respect the fact that Y'hoshafat the king of Y'hudah is here, I wouldn't even look in your direction or take notice of you. But now, bring me a musician." As the musician played, the hand of Adonai fell on Elisha; and he said, "Adonai says to dig until this valley is full of trenches. For here is what Adonai says: 'You won't see wind, and you won't see rain. Nevertheless the valley will be filled with water; and you will drink — you, your cattle and your other animals. That's an easy thing to do, from Adonai's perspective. He will also hand Mo'av over to you.

- The music inspired the prophet's gift in him. Music can inspire a move of the Spirit and the gifts within a person to be manifest.
- Praise & Worship is a "peace offering" and a "pleasing aroma" to the Lord!
- Psa 50:14, Psa 50:23; Psa 69:30-31, Psa 107:21-22, Psa 116:17-19 & Heb 13:15

## Music Induces the Spirit:

Psalm 22:3 Nevertheless, you are holy, enthroned on the praises of Isra'el.

• Music creates an atmosphere. God dwells in (inhabits) the atmosphere of praise. He actually inhabits our praise. The presence of God is IN the praises; He is IN the music. Our praise brings Him on the scene. Praise manifests His presence. If you need the reality of God in your life, begin to praise Him from the depths of your heart. He will fill your praises and manifest Himself to you.

Psalm 49:4-5 My mouth speaks wisdom, My heart's meditation is understanding. I will turn my ear to a proverb. I will utter my riddle on the harp:

David was singing with harp accompaniment, and it was bringing forth the wisdom of God from his heart. Music will many times inspire and loose the wisdom of God within me, from my heart into my mind.

#### INTERCESSION THROUGH MUSIC:

Intercession accompanied with music by skillful, spirit-led musicians is very powerful. Enemies are defeated, and strongholds come down.

Isa 30:31-32 For Adonai's voice will terrify Ashur, as with his scepter he strikes them down. Every sweep of the punishing rod that Adonai imposes on him will be to tambourines and lyres, as he brandishes his arm against them in battle.

2Ch 20:20-24 Early in the morning they arose and went out into the wilderness of Tekoa. As they went forth, Jehoshaphat stood and said, "Listen to me, O Judah and inhabitants of Jerusalem! Believe in Adonai your God and you will be confirmed. Trust in His prophets and you will succeed." After consulting with the people, he appointed singers to Adonai praising the splendor of His holiness, as they went out before the army saying, "Praise Adonai, `for His mercy endures forever." As they began singing and praising, Adonai set ambushes against the children of Ammon, Moab, and Mount Seir who had come against Judah, and they were defeated. For the Ammonites and Moabites rose up against the inhabitants of Mount Seir to exterminate and annihilate them. When they had exterminated the inhabitants of Seir, they helped to destroy one another. When Judah came to the lookout in the wilderness and looked for the multitude, behold, only corpses were lying on the ground—no one had escaped.

## Prophecy with Instruments!

1Chron 25:1-7 Moreover, David and the commanders of the army, set apart for avodah the sons of Asaph, Heman, and Jeduthun who prophesied with lyres, harps and cymbals. The list of those who performed this work according to their service was: from the sons of Asaph: Zaccur, Joseph, Nethaniah, and Asarelah. The sons of Asaph were under the supervision of Asaph, who prophesied under the hand of the king. As for Jeduthun, from Jeduthun's sons: Gedaliah, Zeri, Jeshaiah, Hashabiah and Mattithiah—six, under the charge of their father Jeduthun—who prophesied with the harp, giving thanks and praise to Adonai. As for Heman, from Heman's sons: Bukkiah, Mattaniah, Uzziel, Shebuel, Jerimoth, Hananiah, Hanani, Eliathah, Giddalti, and Romamti-ezer, Joshbekashah, Mallothi, Hothir and Mahazioth. All these were the sons of Heman the king's seer according to the promise of God to lift up a horn. God gave Heman 14 sons and three daughters. All these were under the direction of their father for singing in the House of Adonai with cymbals, harps and lyres for the avodah of the House of God under the hand of the king. Asaph, Jeduthun, and Heman along with with their kinsmen all trained and skillfull singers of Adonai, numbered 288.

## Not just from the Tanakh:

Psalms, Hymns, Spiritual Songs, in your heart and from your heart!

Ephesians 5:18-19 And do not get drunk on wine, for that is recklessness. Instead, be filled with the Ruach, speaking to one another in psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs, singing and making music in your heart to the Lord—

Colossians 3:15-16 Let the shalom of Messiah rule in your hearts—to this shalom you were surely called in one body. Also be thankful. Let the word of Messiah dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another with all wisdom in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with gratitude in your hearts to God.

  - o 1 Cor 12:10 Discernment, Tongues, Interpretation of Tongues
  - 1Cor 12:7 Moreover, to each person is given the particular manifestation of the Spirit that will be for the common good.

1Cor 12:11 One and the same Spirit is at work in all these things, distributing to each person as he chooses.
