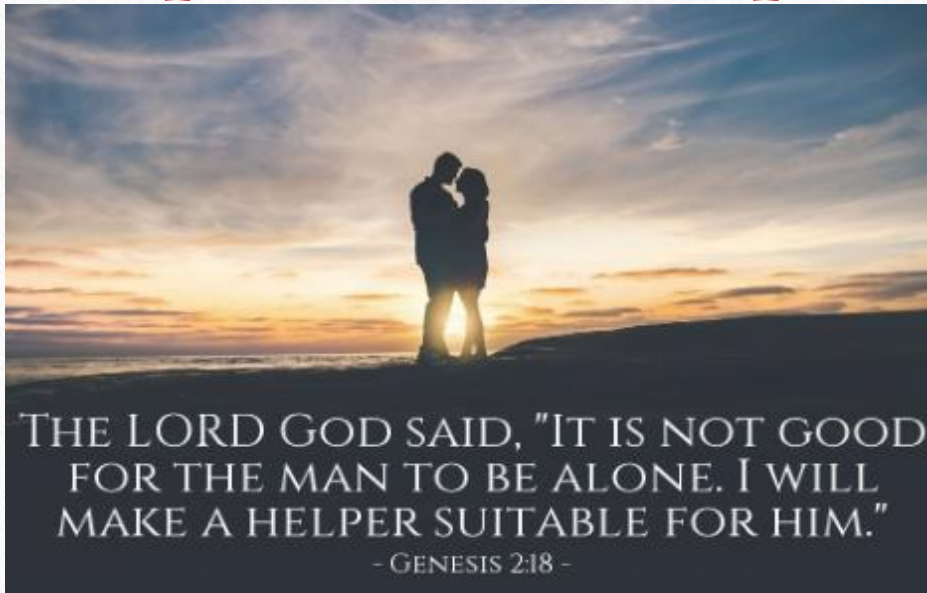

A Helper Opposite/Corresponding

• Ezer

- “The LORD is my help (ezer)” Ps 121:2
- “You have been my help (ezer)” Ps 70:5
- God is Israel’s “shield and helper” (ezer) Deut 33:29
- Ezer is a capable deliverer, one who supplies what is lacking or rescues in need.

Ch’Negedo

- Equal and opposite. counterpart
- Corresponding to him. suitable/fit/matching
- NOT identical but matching in difference.
- Azer k’negdo = a strong help who stands face-to-face, neither above nor below, but corresponding, complementary, and sometimes confronting for his good.
- This is not an assistant. It is more like: “the one who supplies what he lacks by bringing her difference.”

A Helper Opposite/Corresponding

- Equal (image-bearer, Gen. 1:26–27)
- Necessary (man is “not good” alone)
- Distinct (not a clone but a counterpart)
- Complementary (brings what he does not have)
- Face-to-face (an ally and mirror, not a subordinate)
- Her opposition is part of the help. She supplies strengths, sensitivities, and perspectives he lacks. It is a constructive “opposite” not adversarial but counterbalancing.

A Helper Opposite/Corresponding

Abigail to David (1 Samuel 25)

- Discerns what David does not.
- Counsels him in wisdom.
- Prevents him from bloodshed.
- Speaks truth boldly.
- Complements (and corrects) a future king. “Blessed be your discernment... for keeping me from bloodshed.” ~ David, 1 Sam 25:33
- She opposes David’s impending sin and thus helps him. This is ezer k’negdo in action!

Moses and Jethro (Exodus 18)

- Sees Moses burning out.
- Confronts his leadership blind spot.
- Offers an alternative system.
- Moses consults God, good advice!
- Corrects for Moses’s good. This is the “opposite” bringing wisdom to the one who cannot see his own need.

Two Become One Flesh

- **Gen 2:24** Therefore a man will leave his father and his mother, and will join with his wife, and **they will be one flesh.**
- **Mat 19:4-6** He answered, and said, "Have not you read that he who made them from the beginning made them male and female, (5) and said, 'For this cause a man shall leave his father and mother, and shall join to his wife; and the **two shall become one flesh?** (6) So that they are no more two, but one flesh. What therefore God has joined together, do not let man tear apart."

Jezebel, refuses to become one

- אֵי זֶבֶל (i zével) “not dwelling / without cohabitation.”
- Even though “married” she operates on her own initiative.
- Not equally yoked
- Refuses to become one. (**Rev 2:20**)
- This is prominent in both sexes, Not exclusive to females.

One Whole Being!

Half the man without the other half!

Rom 16:7 Greetings to Andronicus and Junia...

1Co 16:19 . Aquila and Priscilla....

1Co 16:24 My love is with you all, in union with the Messiah Yeshua.

• Tit 2:4-5 thus training the younger women to love their husbands and children, (5) to be self-controlled and pure, to take good care of their homes and submit to their husbands. In this way, God's message will not be brought into disgrace.

Eph 5:23-33 For the husband is the head of the wife, and Messiah also is the head of the congregation, *being himself the savior of the body.* (24) But as the congregation is subject to Messiah, so *let the wives also be to their own husbands in everything.* (25) *Husbands, love your wives, even as Messiah also loved the congregation, and gave himself up for it;* (26) that he might sanctify it, having cleansed it by the washing of water with the word, (27) that he might present the congregation to himself gloriously, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish. (28) Even so husbands also ought to love their own wives as their own bodies. He who loves his own wife loves himself. (29) For no man ever hated his own flesh; but nourishes and cherishes it, even as Messiah also does the congregation; (30) because we are members of his body. (31) "For this cause a man will leave his father and mother, and will be joined to his wife. The two will become one flesh." (32) This mystery is great, but I speak concerning Messiah and of the congregation. (33) Nevertheless each of you must also love his own wife even as himself; *and let the wife see that she respects her husband.*

5:23 For the husband is the head of the wife, and Messiah also is the head of the congregation, being himself the savior of the body. *What does this mean?*

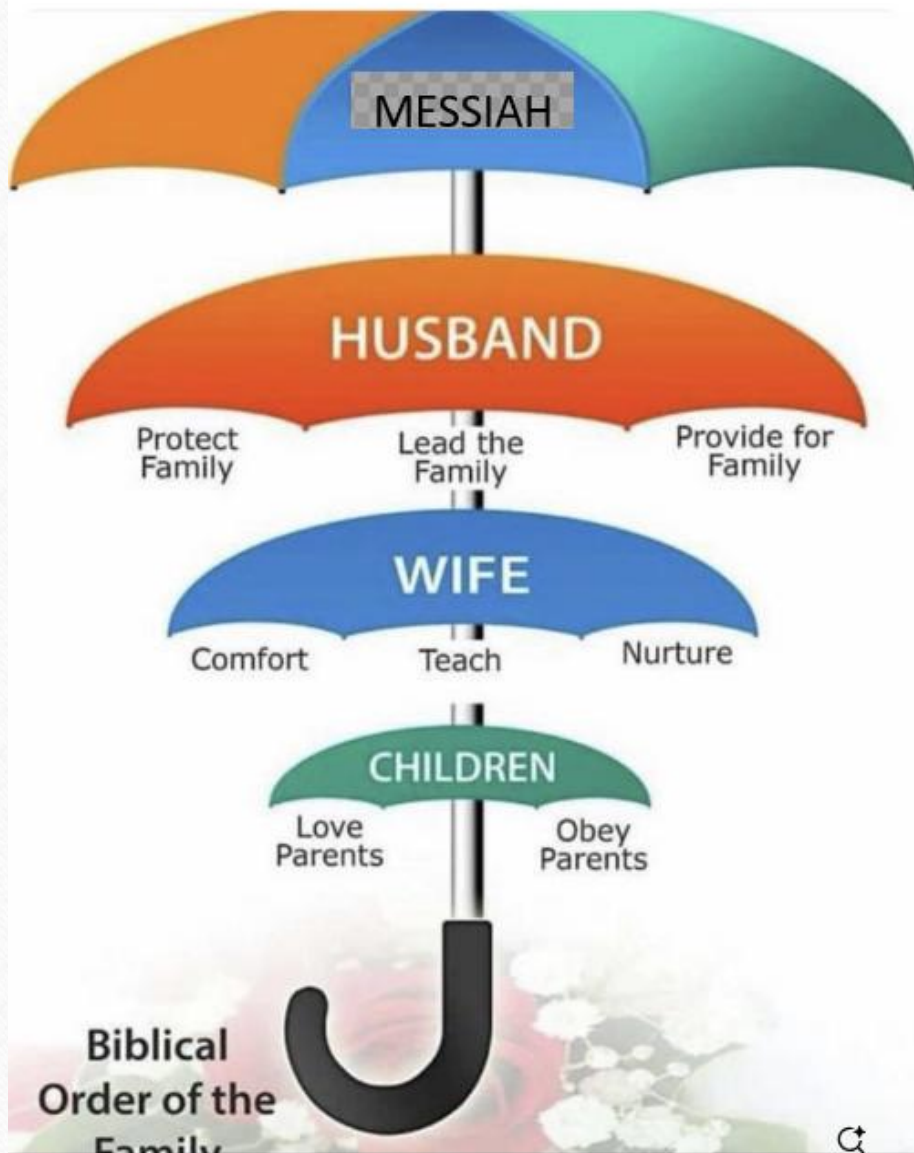
5:24 But as the congregation is subject to Messiah, so let the wives also be to their own husbands in everything *In sin too?*

Husbands

Husband's Responsibility

Gen 2:15 Then Adonai Elohim took the man and gave him rest in the Garden of Eden in order to **cultivate** (עָבַד) and **watch over** it (שָׁמַר).

Num 18:7 But you and your sons with you are to **maintain** (שָׁמַר) your priesthood for everything pertaining to the altar and inside the parokhet. I am giving you the **ministry** (עָבַד) of the priesthood as a gift. Anyone unauthorized who approaches will die."

- **Shomar** (שָׁמַר) Guard
- **Avod** (עָבַד) Work, serve, worship
- Men are responsible for what goes on in the house, physically & spiritually.
- Example: Pinchas example **Num 25:6-11**

Deuteronomy 6:7 You are to teach them diligently to your children, and speak of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down and when you rise up.

Husband's Responsibility

Rule your Household Well!

In the Torah, the Cohen must be clean & Holy prior to ministering to the people: **Lev 16, Lev 8 & 9, Exo 30:17-21, Num 8, Lev 21 & 22, Exo 19:22-24.**

1Tim 3:4-5 One who rules his own house well, having children in subjection with all reverence; (but if a man does not know how to rule his own house, how will he take care of the congregation of God?)

Eli, a weak father to Hofni & Pinchas:

- **1Sam 2:12:** Now Eli's sons were worthless men; they did not acknowledge Adonai.
- **1Sam 2:22-26:** A weak rebuke
- **1Sam 3:1:** Deterred Gods presence
- **1Sam 4:18:** Israel defeated, Eli & sons dead!

Weak men cause chaos and deter Gods presence and blessing. Negatively impacting all!

Husband's Responsibility

A weak leader says:

Gen 3:12 Then the man said, "The woman whom You gave to be with me - she gave me of the Tree, and I ate."

A strong leader says:

Mat 26:39 Going a little farther, He fell face down and prayed, saying, "My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from Me! Yet not as I will, but as You will."

John 19:30 When Yeshua tasted the sour wine, He said, "It is finished!" And He bowed His head and gave up His spirit.

More Scriptures on Husbands

Mutual submission:

Eph 5:21 Also submit yourselves to one another out of reverence for Messiah—
5:22 wives to your own husbands as to the Lord.

Colossians 3:19 Husbands, love your wives, and do not be bitter against them.

1Peter 3:7 You husbands, in like manner, live with your wives according to knowledge, giving honor to the woman, as to the weaker vessel, as being also joint heirs of the grace of life; that your prayers may not be hindered.

Titus 1:6 if anyone is blameless, the husband of one wife, having children who believe, who are not accused of loose or unruly behavior.

What are Wives supposed to do?

Gen 2:18 The LORD God said, "It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him a **helper suitable** for him." Hebrew (Helper or counterpart before him)

Gen 2:21-25 The LORD God caused a deep sleep to fall on the man, and he slept; and he took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh in its place. (22) He made the rib, which the LORD God had taken from the man, into a woman, and brought her to the man. (23) The man said, "This is now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh. She will be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man." (24) Therefore a man will leave his father and his mother, and will join with his wife, and they will be one flesh.

Eph 5:22 Wives, be subject to your own husbands, as to the Lord.

Eph 5:24 But as the congregation is subject to Messiah, so let the wives also be to their own husbands in everything.

1Ti 3:11 Their wives in the same way must be reverent, not slanderers, temperate, faithful in all things.

What are Wives supposed to do?

1Pe 3:1 In like manner, wives, be in subjection to your own husbands; so that, even if any do not obey the Word, they may be won by the behavior of their wives without a word;

Mat 5:32 but I tell you that everyone who puts away his wife, except for the cause of sexual immorality, makes her an adulteress; and whoever marries her when she is put away commits adultery.

Act 5:9 But Peter asked her, "How is it that you have agreed together to tempt the Spirit of the Lord? Behold, the feet of those who have buried your husband are at the door, and they will carry you out."

1Co 7:2-4 But, because of sexual immoralities, let each man have his own wife, and let each woman have her own husband. (3) Let the husband fulfill his marital duty to his wife, and likewise also the wife to her husband. (4) The wife does not have authority over her own body, but the husband. Likewise, also the husband does not have authority over his own body, but the wife.

Scripture Wisdom the “How To” of Relationship!

Pro 12:18 There is one who speaks rashly like the piercing of a sword, but the tongue of the wise heals.

Pro 15:1-4 A gentle answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger. The tongue of the wise commends knowledge, but the mouth of fools gush out folly. YHWH's eyes are everywhere, keeping watch on the evil and the good. A gentle tongue is a tree of life, but deceit in it crushes the spirit.

Discipline and Discipleship

- Discipline → forms → a Disciple → who lives in → Discipleship.
- Or even shorter: **No Discipline = No Discipleship.**
- If one refuses the training (Heb: musar, Grk: paideia (Discipline)), one cannot become a Disciple.

This is why Yeshua said: *“If anyone wants to come after me, let him say 'No' to himself, take up his execution-stake daily and keep following me.”* ~ **Luke 9:23**

“Even though he was the Son, he learned obedience through his sufferings. .” ~ **Hebrews 5:8**

- This does not mean He was sinful; rather, He was trained in obedience through endurance, modeling perfect sonship.

Discipline out of Love

We discipline our children out of Love, motivated to correct and restore:

Heb 12:5 Have you forgotten the warning addressed to you as sons? “My son, do not take lightly the discipline of Adonai or lose heart when you are corrected by Him,
Heb 12:6 because ***Adonai disciplines the one He loves*** and punishes every son He accepts.”

Heb 12:7 It is for discipline that you endure. God is treating you as sons—for what son does a father not discipline?

Heb 12:8 But if you are without discipline—something all have come to share—then you are illegitimate and not sons.

Heb 12:9 Besides, we are used to having human fathers as instructors—and we respected them. Shall we not much more be subject to the Father of spirits and live?

Heb 12:10 Indeed, for a short time they disciplined us as seemed best to them; but He does so for our benefit, so that we may share in His holiness.

Heb 12:11 Now all discipline seems painful at the moment—not joyful. ***But later it yields the peaceful fruit of righteousness to those who have been trained by it.***

Discipline out of Love

LOVE is our MOTIVE!

Rev 3:19 Those whom I love, I rebuke and discipline. Therefore, be zealous and repent.

1Corinthians 13:12-13 For now we see obscurely in a mirror, but then it will be face to face. Now I know partly; then I will know fully, just as God has fully known me. But for now, three things last — **faith, hope, love**; and the greatest of these is love.

- Faith is the action
- Hope is the vision
- Love is the motive

Pro 13:24 He who spares the rod **hates** his son, but ***he who loves him is diligent with discipline.***

Discipline out of Love

Contrary to popular belief, we do not “hate” our children when we discipline. We do it because we LOVE them! Love is our motive!

2Tim 3:16 All Scripture is inspired by God and useful for teaching, for reproof, for **restoration**, and for training in righteousness (TLV)

2Ti 3:16 All Scripture is God-breathed and is valuable for teaching the truth, convicting of sin, **correcting faults** and training in right living (CJB)

Discipline to Restore!

How to Discipline

Eph 6:1-4 Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. right. “Honor your father and mother” (which is the first commandment with a promise), “so that it may be well with you, and you may live long on the earth.” Fathers, *do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.*

Gifts can be conditional upon obedience, example the land etc...

- Destruction is only the end when correction and discipline is ignored:
 - Rebellious child to the gate, **Deuteronomy: 21:18-21**

What does the World Teach? (They tell half-truths and Lies)?

From Harvard Medical School: "According to a policy statement (Effective Discipline to Raise Healthy Children) recently released by the American Academy of Pediatrics, "aversive" discipline techniques like yelling and spanking are a really bad idea. Not only do studies show that they don't work that well, they can have long-term negative effects."

From the American Academy of Pediatrics: Spanking and harsh words are harmful and don't work. Here's why: "Effective Discipline to Raise Healthy Children," highlights why it's important to focus on teaching good behavior rather than punishing bad behavior. Research shows that spanking, slapping and other forms of physical punishment don't work well to correct a child's behavior. The same holds true for yelling at or shaming a child. Beyond being ineffective, harsh physical and verbal punishments can also damage a child's long-term physical and mental health.

Children's Hospital of Philadelphia: "By modeling aggressive behavior, these kinds of discipline can lead children to act in more aggressive ways with their peers, and as they grow up, with intimate partners and their own children.

Research has shown a relationship between these kinds of discipline and higher rates of depression and other mental health problems later in life.

The negative outcomes for children who are spanked are similar to those for children who experience physical abuse."

What does His Word Teach? Ezekiel's Example:

Eze 20:37-44 "I will cause you to ***pass under the rod***, and I will bring you into the bond of the covenant; (38) and I will purge out from among you the rebels, and those who disobey against me; I will bring them forth out of the land where they live, but they shall not enter into the land of Israel: and you shall know that I am YHWH." (39) "As for you, house of Israel, thus says the Lord YHWH: "Go, serve everyone his idols, and hereafter also, if you will not listen to me; but my holy name you shall no more profane with your gifts, and with your idols. (40) For in my holy mountain, in the mountain of the height of Israel," says the Lord YHWH, "there shall all the house of Israel, all of them, serve me in the land: there will I accept them, and there will I require your offerings, and the first fruits of your offerings, with all your holy things. (41) ***As a pleasant aroma will I accept you, when I bring you out from the peoples, and gather you out of the countries in which you have been scattered; and I will be sanctified in you in the sight of the nations.*** (42) You shall know that I am YHWH, when I shall bring you into the land of Israel, into the country which I swore to give to your fathers. (43) There you shall remember your ways, and all your doings, in which you have polluted yourselves; and you shall loathe yourselves in your own sight for all your evils that you have committed. (44) You shall know that I am YHWH, when I have dealt with you for my name's sake, not according to your evil ways, nor according to your corrupt doings, you house of Israel," says the Lord YHWH."

What does His Word Teach?

Exo 14:16 *Lift up your rod*, and stretch out your hand over the sea, and divide it: and the children of Israel shall go into the midst of the sea on dry ground.

Psa 23:4 Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me. ***Your rod and your staff, they comfort me.***

Psa 89:31-33 if they break my statutes, and do not keep my commandments; then ***I will punish their sin with the rod***, and their iniquity with stripes. (33) But I will not completely take my loving kindness from him, nor allow my faithfulness to fail.

Pro 13:24 ***One who spares the rod hates his son***, but one who loves him is careful to discipline him.

Pro 22:15 Folly is ***bound up in the heart of a child: the rod of discipline drives it far from him.***

Pro 23:13-14 ***Do not withhold correction from a child. If you punish him with the rod, he will not die. (14) Punish him with the rod and save his soul from Sheol.***

Pro 29:15 The ***rod of correction*** gives wisdom, but a child left to himself causes shame to his mother.

What does His Word Teach?

Mic 6:9 YHWH's voice calls to the city, and wisdom sees your name: "***Listen to the rod, and he who appointed it.***

Rev 19:15 Out of his mouth proceeds a sharp sword, that with it he should strike the nations. He will rule them with an iron rod. He treads the winepress of the fierceness of the wrath of God, the Almighty.

Pro 14:3 The ***fool's talk brings a rod to his back***, but the lips of the wise protect them.

Pro 26:3 A whip is for the horse, a bridle for the donkey, and a ***rod for the back of fools!***

1Co 4:20-21 For the Kingdom of God is not in word, but in power. (21) What do you want? ***Shall I come to you with a rod***, or in love and a spirit of gentleness?

Mat 19:13-15 Then little children were brought to him, that he should ***lay his hands*** on them and pray; and the disciples rebuked them. (14) But Jesus said, "Allow the little children, and do not forbid them to come to me; for the Kingdom of Heaven belongs to ones like these." (15) He placed his hands on them, and departed from there.

Who is in charge of Discipline in the Household?

1. It is clear from scripture that *the Husband is in charge* and ultimately it His responsibility to oversee this in the believer's home.
2. If the Husband is at work, he can delegate that responsibility to His Wife
3. Yet it is **his** responsibility to finish what happened during the day. He is in charge of the discipline not the wife.

Learnings from His Word Regarding Discipline

- **He Has appointed the Rod**(Micah) His Word teaches **the Rod** is for discipline. Are your hands a rod? Is your yelling a rod? Is Shaming a rod?
- **Hands are for loving!** (Yeshua's example in Matt)
- YHWH's example is **using the rod, for the result of repentance & restoration.** There are many examples in Scripture about YHWH's rod coming on His people to work out sin and defilement through repentance and restoration.
- **From me: Discipline with the rod,** ask the child to repent, If not, discipline again, once the child had repented, restore him, forgive them and hug them.
- **This is not about shaming, but showing them that sin gets the rod, and hands love!**
- When spanking use a **rod that stings** but does not wound, remember this is about repentance/restoring not taking our frustration out!

Family Studies

Child Outcomes in Whole vs. Divorced Households

- **Educational Outcomes:** *Children of divorce are 8% less likely to finish high school* than those from two-parent families poverty.ucdavis.edu.
- **Mental Health:** *Children of divorce face ~2× higher risk of serious psychological problems* than peers from intact homes nationalaffairs.com.
- **Economic Outcomes:** Nearly *2× greater likelihood of living in poverty* for children of divorce vs. those in two-parent families pmc.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov.
- **Risk Behaviors:** *Teen motherhood is almost 3× more common among girls from divorced families* (33% vs 11%) nationalaffairs.com.
- **Long-Term Adult Outcomes:** Couples with both partners from divorced families have *~3× higher divorce rates than those from intact families* iflscience.com.

Fathers are Faith leaders!

Mother Only Believes

Only ~2% of children become regular churchgoers in adulthood when raised solely by a churchgoing mother touchstonemag.com. *Children rarely continue in the faith when only the mother practices.*

Father Only Believes

About 44% of children become regular churchgoers as adults when only the father is a practicing believer touchstonemag.com. *A father's faith alone significantly boosts the likelihood of children adopting the faith.*

Both Parents Believe

Roughly 74% of children become regular adult churchgoers when both parents attend regularly ignitedbytruth.org. *Having two devout parents yields the highest overall faith retention among children.*

Discipline & Child Outcomes

- **Academic Performance:** *Authoritative style correlates with better grades* (r=0.17);
 - authoritarian/permissive linked to lower achievement academia.edu.
- **Emotional Health:** *Authoritative parenting supports better teen emotional health* (less anxiety/depression);
 - authoritarian/neglectful linked to more issues academia.edu.
- **Behavioral Outcomes:** *Authoritative parenting is linked to fewer behavior problems;*
 - authoritarian, permissive, uninvolved styles yield more conduct issues pubmed.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov.
- **Social Competence:** *Authoritative parenting fosters greater social competence (better peer relationships);*
 - authoritarian/permissive show no such gains child-encyclopedia.com
- **Long-Term Life Outcomes:** *Authoritative parenting yields happier, more successful adults (higher life satisfaction);*
 - other styles often lead to poorer outcomes verywellmind.com.
