

• 4th Century Roman Empire Becomes Christian & Outlaws Anything Disagreeing With Nicene Orthodoxy



"Edict of Thessalonica XVI, 1, 2 - A.D. 380 "All are to be Catholic Christians. "Those who follow this law we command shall be comprised under the name of Catholic Christians; but others, indeed, we require, as insane and raving, to bear the infamy of heretical teaching; their gatherings shall not receive thename of churches; they are to be smitten first with the divine punishment and after that by the vengeance of our indignation, which has the divine approval."

Edict of Thessalonica XVI, 1, 3 - A.D. 381 Trusted bishops "all who dissent from the communion of the faith of those whom the special list has named ought to be expelled from the churches as manifest heretics... that the priestly orders of the true and Nicene faith may remain pure"

Simplified History Of The Messianic (Kingdom) Movement

• <u>Late 4th/early 5th Century - There Is Still A Remnant Of The Early Messianic Movement</u>

"We must first root this ailment out and then take thought for matters outside; we must first cure our own and then be concerned for others who are strangers. What is this disease? The festivals of the pitiful and miserable Jews are soon to march upon us... others will join the Jews in keeping their feasts and observing their fasts. I wish to drive this perverse custom from the Church right now... Therefore, flee the gatherings and holy places of the Jews. Let no man venerate the synagogue because of the holy books; let him hate and avoid it" - John Chrysostom, Against the Jews (To Church In Antioch) Homily 1

Simplified History Of The Messianic (Kingdom) Movement

• 4th/5th Century – Clear Prophesies About The Millennial Kingdom Become Spiritualized Away

"If we accept [the Apocalypse] literally, [we] must Judaize; if we treat it spiritually, as it is written, we shall seem to go against the opinions of many of the ancients" - Jerome 4th Century Commentary on Isaiah Preface to Book 18.

"Therefore the Church even now is the kingdom of Christ, and the kingdom of heaven. Accordingly, even now His saints reign with Him" – Augustine 5th Century City Of God Book 20 Chapter 9

• <u>1500's AD Messianic Movement Persecuted Under Holy Roman Empire</u>

"heresy and treason—that is, who had in any way practiced anything Jewish—to confess. If New Christians admitted their crimes early and willingly, perhaps also beneficently supplying the names of other lapsed Christians, their punishments varied—but were guaranteed to be less irrevocable than death. If they confessed after a conviction, they earned themselves a "good" death: quick and merciful strangulation before being burned publicly at the stake [the quemadero]. If, like Isabel, they insisted on their innocence to the end, they were often first tortured, and then delivered to the ghastly pain of conscious cremation" - Legajoo 162: The Rediscovered Case of Isabel Lopez, Burned at the Stake November 30, 1518

"Jews who never converted to Christianity were not under the jurisdiction of the Inquisition, and could practice their religion freely and openly. It was only conversos who were considered heretics for forsaking the Christian creed and practicing Judaism. If the Inquisitors could not obtain a confession from a suspected heretic, they employed torture to extract one" - Chabad.org The Spanish Inquisition By Yosef Eisen

Simplified History Of The Messianic (Kingdom) Movement

October 31, 1517 Martin Luther Posts His 95 Theses



"I hope that if one deals in a kindly way with the Jews and instructs them carefully from Holy Scripture, many of them will become genuine Christians and turn again to the faith of their fathers, the prophets and patriarchs. They will only be frightened further away from it if their Judaism is so utterly rejected that nothing is allowed to remain, and they are treated only with arrogance and scorn. If the apostles, who also were Jews, had dealt with us Gentiles as we Gentiles deal with the Jews, there would never have been a Christian among the Gentiles. "Martin Luther 1523 That Jesus Christ Was Born a Jew

Simplified History Of The Messianic (Kingdom) Movement

Mid-To-Late 1500's Some Jews Converted To Protestantism (Though Extremely Rare)



Immanuel Tremellius - "was converted about 1540 to the Catholic faith through Cardinal Pole, but embraced Protestantism in the following year, and went to Strasburg to teach Hebrew. Owing to the wars of the Reformation in Germany he was compelled to <u>seek asylum in England</u>, where he resided at Lambeth Palace with Archbishop Cranmer in 1547. In 1549 he succeeded Paul Fagius as regius professor of Hebrew at Cambridge." – https://www.jewishencyclopedia.com/articles/14495-tremellius-john-immanuel

Simplified History Of The Messianic (Kingdom) Movement

• England 1534-1809 Steps The Reformation Closer To The Original Messianic Movement



- 1534 England Breaks Away From The Catholic Church
- 1656 Jews were readmitted to England (after being banned for over 366 years)
- 1809 The London Society for Promoting Christianity Amongst the Jews is created (later became The Church's Ministry Among Jewish People/CMJ).

Missionaries were sent to major Jewish population centers in Europe, Russia, North Africa, and the Middle East.

Simplified History Of The Messianic (Kingdom) Movement

• <u>1884 Joseph Rabinowitz A Russian Jew Who Came To Faith In Yeshua</u>

<u>Establishes The First Modern Messianic Synagogue – B'nai Israel, Bnai B'rith Chadashah</u>







The Jewish community of Kishinev was outraged at the establishment of this supposed "church-synagogue" and told czarist government officials about it. Eventually, the government ordered the church shut down. "The Russian authorities were nervous about the rapid rise of Protestant Christianity," explained lemima Ploscariu, an expert on 19th century messianic Jewish leaders. "They saw it as heretical to Russian Orthodoxy."

Simplified History Of The Messianic (Kingdom) Movement

1885 Joseph Rabinowitz published a "Symbol of the Israelites of the New Covenant"







Rabinowitz's work gained support from Western European missions and was a significant development in the Messianic Jewish movement because it gave guidance on how Jews could continue to keep the Torah while believing in Yeshua as Messiah; something that for many centuries was deemed incompatible.

Joseph Rabinowitz's influence reached Rabbi Leopold Cohn in Brooklyn, NY who after becoming a believer in Yeshua, in 1894 founded Brownsville Mission to the Jews (eventually became Chosen People Ministries)

- 1967 Jerusalem Back Under Jewish Control For The First Time Since The Destruction Of The Temple In 70 AD
- "Jerusalem will be trampled by the Gentiles until the times of the Gentiles are fulfilled" Luke 21:24




In 1970 Martin Chernoff had a series of visions The 3rd one said "Two electrifying simple words stretched across the sky in the form of a banner." He saw the words: Messianic Judaism.

The small group of Jewish believers in Cincinnati confessed: "We are Jewish believers in Yeshua as our Messiah. We have our own destiny in the Lord. We will no longer be assimilated into the church and pretend to be non-Jews. If Yeshua Himself, His followers and the early Jewish believers tenaciously maintained their Jewish lifestyles, why was it right for them, but wrong now? Gentile converts are not expected to forsake their families, culture, holidays and traditions; nor shall we do so." No longer would they call themselves Hebrew Christians, but Messianic Jews. .. Two years later, the young hippie believers far outnumbered the old guard and the name was changed from the Hebrew Christian Alliance of America HCAA to the Messianic Jewish Alliance of America (MJAA)." - https://mycharisma.com/news/martin-chernoff-the-father-of-20th-century-messianic-judaism/

Founders



Adat was founded by David and Ester Bronstein in 1934, as the First Hebrew Christian Church of Chicago. It was formed out of the Jewish mission house ministry known as Peniel Center. The name was changed to Adat Hatikvah in 1974.

Adat is currently located in Deerfield IL. However it was located in Albany Park, East Rogers Park, West Rogers Park, and Evanston.

How did Olive Tree Congregation come into existence?

Olive Tree was planted in 1978 by Roy Schwarcz and John Bell who were serving as missionaries with what is now Chosen People Ministries. Their desire was to plant a Jewish sensitive theologically conservative congregation that could disciple the many Jewish people who were coming to faith at that time. The congregation became financially independent of CPM three years after it was planted.





• We Are Still In The Beginning Of Birth Pains (2025) But Persecution Will Increase

"And you will hear of wars and rumors of wars. See that you are not alarmed, for this must take place, but the end is not yet. For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom, and there will be famines and earthquakes in various places. All these are but the beginning of the birth pains. Yeshua's Lesson From The Fig Tree

"From the fig tree learn its lesson: as soon as its branch becomes tender and puts out its leaves, you know that summer is near. So also, when you see all these things (persecution, lawlessness, antichrist in temple), you know that he is near, at the very gates. Truly, I say to you, this generation will not pass away until all these things take place. Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will not pass away." Matthew 24:32-25

The Fig Tree Yeshua found with no fruit (Matthew 21:19) represented that generation of religious leaders In Israel who rejected Yeshua, so he cursed them to destruction

The Fig Tree In Matthew 24:32-35 that becomes tender and puts out its leaves is Israel coming back into the land. And after 1967 more biological Israelites are beginning to bear fruit. The generation that sees this will likely precursor the final harvest. Summer is the final harvest of fruit before Yeshua fulfills the fall feasts (Jeremiah 8:20, Amos 8:1) with Sukkot being the final feast of ingathering.
